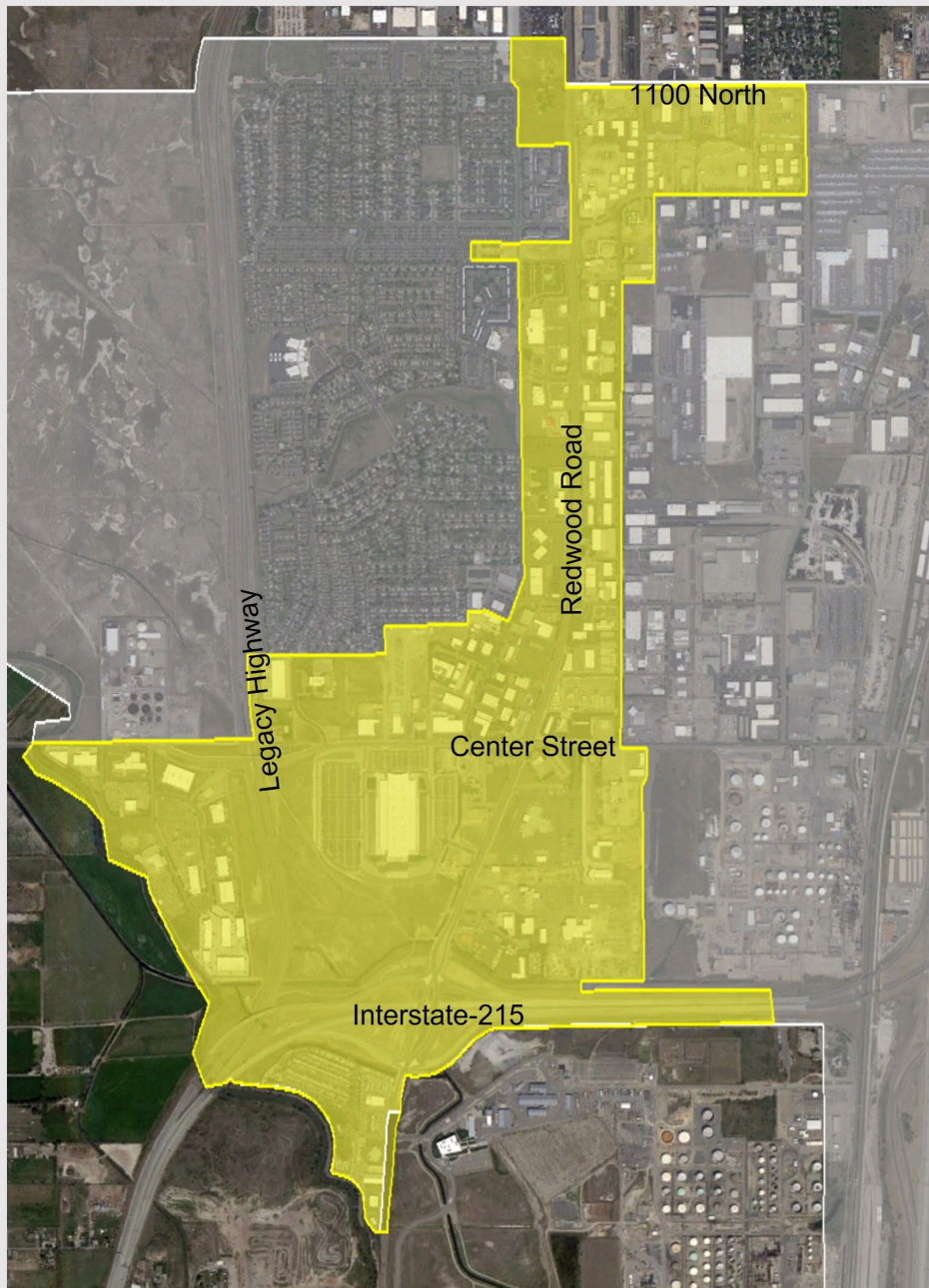

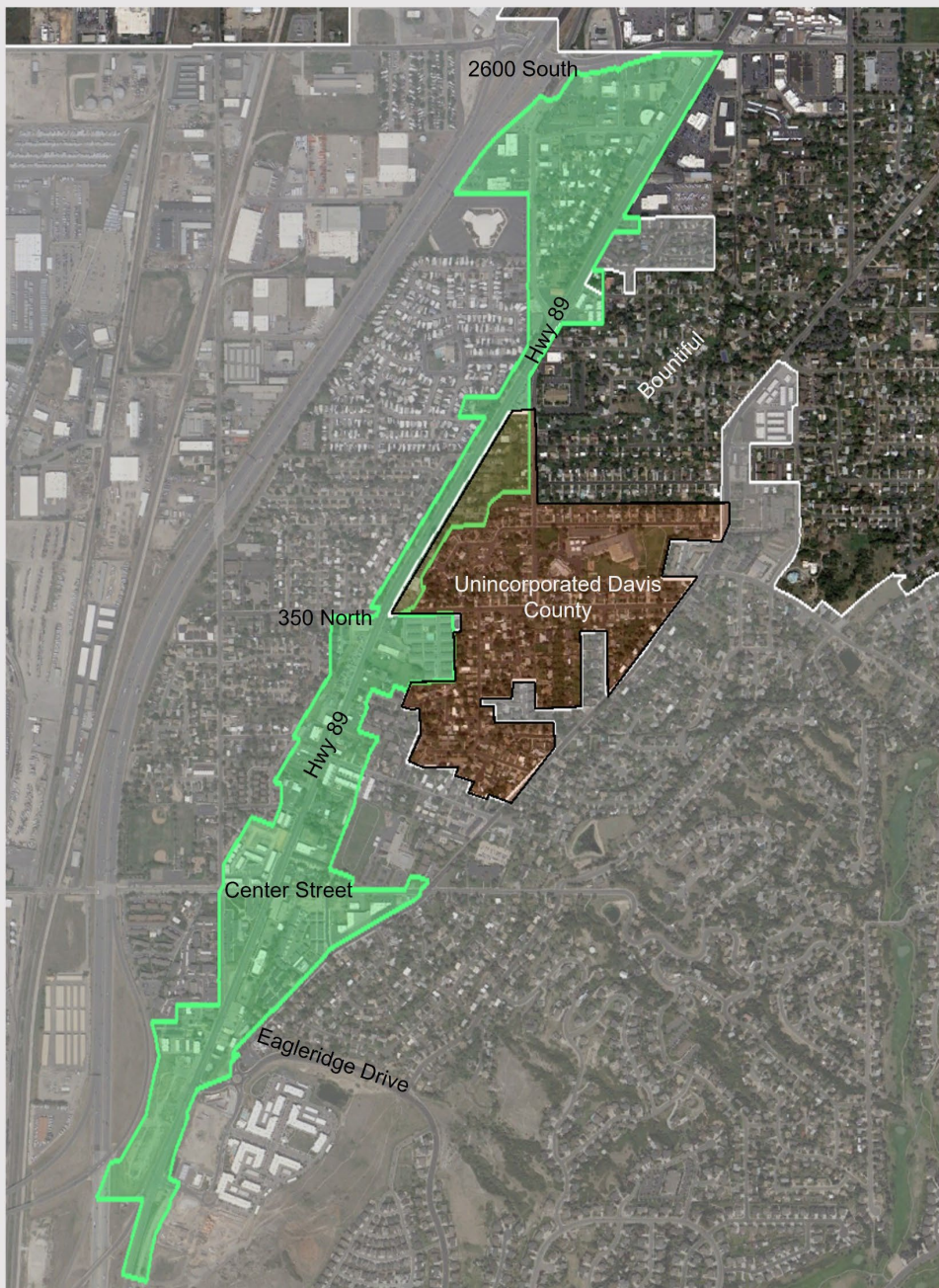




Redwood Road CDA



- One of the largest CDA project areas: 585.34 acres
- Created to:
 - Stimulate private investment
 - Infrastructure enhancement
 - Expand tax base
 - Job creation
- Used to attract Lee's Marketplace (\$1.5 million); built infrastructure for Kimball commercial parcels
- Generates \$1.8 to \$2.6 annually (45% TIF share/15 years)
- Funds bond payments for Wetlands Park and some Hatch Park
- Distribution includes: Housing Fund (10%); General Fund (5%); Debt Service Fund (50% +or-)
- Will generate approximately \$10 million in unrestricted TIF revenue
- Ends in 2032



Highway 89 CDA



- CDA project areas of 127.8 acres
- Created to:
 - Stimulate private investment
 - Expand tax base
 - Job creation
 - Land Assembly, Demolition, Redevelopment
- Used to attract Town Center project (\$2.35 million)
- 40% TIF sharing for 15 years
- Distribution includes: Housing Fund (10%); General Fund (5%); Developer reimbursement (85% +or- and retired this year)
- Will generate approximately \$3 million in unrestricted TIF revenue after reimbursement is complete (2026) until 2031

Redwood Road CDA projects

- 1) Completion of missing sidewalks – east side of Redwood Road, w/grants
- 2) Landscaping improvements – trees, w/owner participation
- 3) Street lighting – uniform design, aesthetic and inviting
- 4) Entry monumentation
- 5) Landscaped medians

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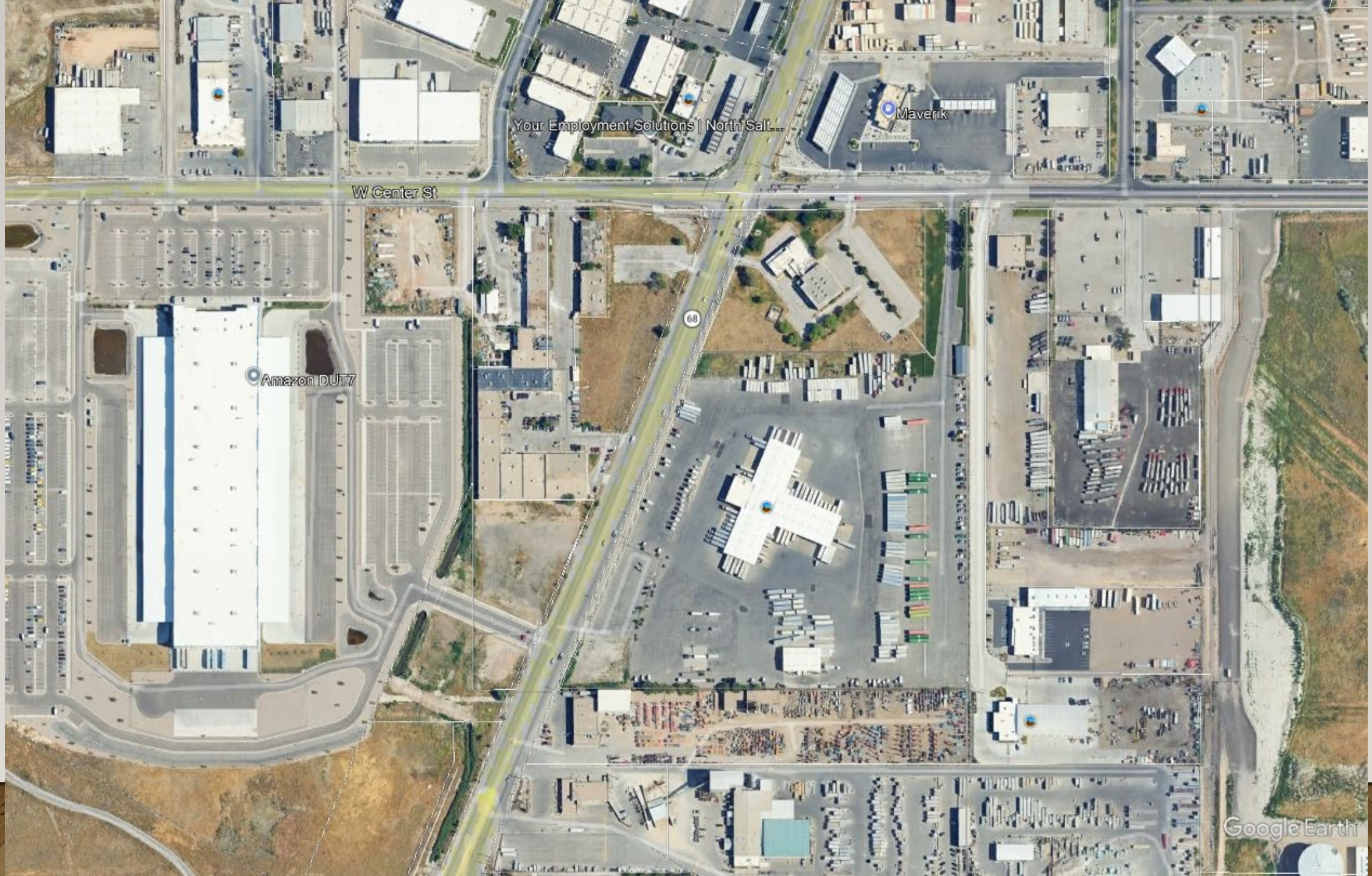
