Approval of March 2026 Court Report- Randy Christiansen presented the court report for March 2026. Total amount taken in \$4,919.07 Salina City portion \$2,379.87 Randy Christiansen motioned to accept the March court report. Allen Tietjen seconded. Motion carried 3 to 0.

Approval of April 2026 Court Report- Randy Christiansen presented the court report for April 2026. Total amount taken in \$2,978.98 Salina City portion \$1,416.81 Randy Christiansen motioned to accept the April court report. Allen Tietjen seconded. Motion carried 3 to 0.

Approval of Ordinance 196-2026 Randy Christiansen stated this ordinance is amending title 13 public services to amend chapter 13.12.012 by adding language outlining property owner's Responsibility of the sewer service lateral from the public sewer main line to the property line. Review America 250 grant **Tammy Hales** reviewed the expenses associated with the America 250 Grant. She reported that \$250 was provided to the Lions Club for Fourth of July parade prizes. Funds were also used to order flags for the Salina Fire Department and prizes for the Salina Library's Silver War Drawing Contest. Mayor Beach asked whether grant funds were available to assist the Rodeo Club with purchasing flags. **Ashlee Larsen** stated that Fire Chief Allen Kiesel had suggested the Rodeo Club borrow the Fire Department's flags for the event. **Tammy Hales** said she would contact Wes Andreason to discuss the matter further.

Tammy Hales reported that Reanna Batt, NS Recreation Director, has submitted her resignation from the Salina Recreation program. The Board is coordinating with R6 regarding the vacancy and will advertise the position in the local newspaper. **Tammy Hales** mentioned that the Salina City ball fields are in need of significant maintenance and improvements. She expressed optimism that the new Recreation Director will be able to address these issues and implement needed upgrades to the facilities.

She also noted that the Recreation Center needs two pitching machines and is still awaiting the installation of batting cages. Additionally, a resident approached the Board about placing a protein drink vending machine at the Recreation Center. The Board agreed to work on a contract for the proposal.

Hales reported that there have been fewer issues with individuals entering the Recreation Center without a valid pass. The Board also discussed hiring part-time staff to assist with various sports programs throughout the year and to coordinate with local high school coaches.

Allen Tietjen stated that he investigated the recycling matter from the previous City Council and found out that it was just for a website.

Randy Christiansen motioned to adjourn the City Council at 7:41 p.m. **Tammy Hales** seconded. Motion carried 3 to 0.
