In alignment with Governor Spencer Cox’s recent executive order establishing temporary statewide fireworks restrictions due to extraordinary wildfire conditions, Uintah City is implementing a comprehensive local ban.

Please be advised that the discharge of all personal, consumer-grade fireworks—including sparklers, aerial displays, and ground-based devices—is strictly prohibited within all residential neighborhoods and throughout the entire municipal boundary of Uintah City.

This restriction is in place to ensure the safety of our residents, protect local property, and minimize severe fire risks within our community during this volatile season.
