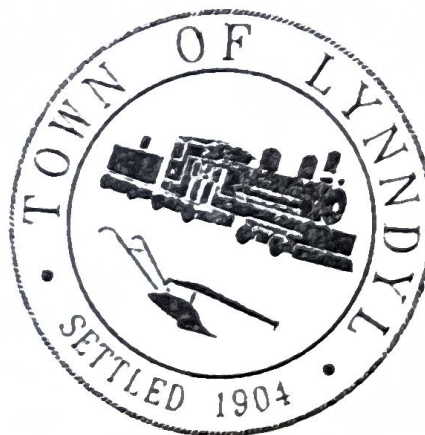
Miff Bishop made a motion to approve, Richard Pyne seconds

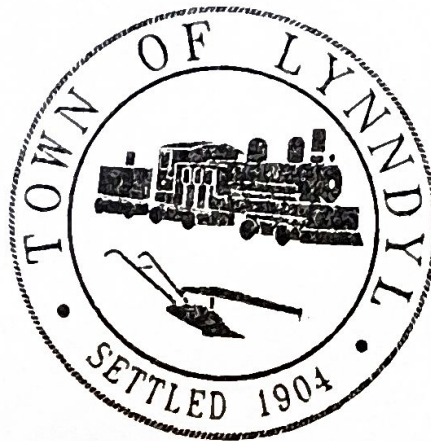
Spencer Proctor – inquired if there will be a fireworks ban on the town of Lynndyl
