Mayor Robert Jenkins
Town Hall.

He has been meeting with the Fire Department concerning public safety. Public safety is a big concern of his. He is trying to find ways to better the community. The Town Hall meeting will be held Friday, June 12th at 6:00 pm everyone is welcome.

Council Member Davis asked Mayor Jenkins if he could put together a list of his wishes and concerns that he could take to the Recreation Committee. Council Member Maxfield said she had an update on the sewer permit. She is in the process of getting “A Permit by Rule”. The permit would allow us to continue doing what we have been doing since 2011. It will need to be renewed every five years. Recorder Bigler mentioned Tyler is in the process of doing the lead/copper samples. He has been working with her to get correct addresses. Most of the addresses used last year did not exist or were not valid. The new address list was sent to the State and was approved. Council Member Davis asked how the Recreation Committee has ordered food in the past. Recorder Bigler explained the process. The Council thinks it would be a good idea for the city to get its own Sam’s Club account.
