CALL TO ORDER and APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES - Utility Advisory Board – March 11, 2026

**MEETING SUMMARY:**

The meeting began with the approval of minutes from the March 11th meeting. Board members introduced themselves. New Board members include Anders Sorensen, Eric Nord and Frank Young. The main discussion focused on proposed utility rate increases. Jason Miller presented a 2% increase for electrical rates, citing inflation and energy costs. Jeff Anderson proposed a 4.4% increase for water rates, and Jake Nostrom suggested a 4.6% increase for wastewater and stormwater rates. The board decided to table the Public Works rate increases for further review and discussion at the next meeting.
