Item: 3 **Update on City parks, trails and trees, open space parcels, Hamlet easement**

- The Warm Springs Trail remains in design and is anticipated to begin construction next year.
- The Trail Master Plan continues to guide future trail priorities, including trail connections throughout the community and opportunities along Pine Canyon Road.

- Regional trail connections between Midway, Deer Creek, and Heber Valley are being pursued through the Utah Trail Network and other long-range planning efforts.
- The Lundin, Heart of Midway, Pear Tree Llama, and Mitchell-Kissel conservation easement projects continue to move forward.
- The Hamlet open space parcel may accommodate future recreational uses permitted under the public access easement, including a dog park and pump track.
- The Ameyalli public access easement provides an opportunity for future geothermal recreation, subject to funding, planning, and engineering considerations.
- Grant funding, impact fees, and other funding sources remain important tools for future parks, trails, and recreation projects.
