V. Approve submission of proposed rule amendments to the Office of Administrative Rules for publication in the *Utah State Bulletin* [action item]

1. R861-1A-32. Mediation Process Pursuant to Utah Code Section 63G-4-102.
2. R865-19S-43. Sales to or by Religious and Charitable Institutions Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. Section 59-12-104.

Commissioner Rockwell: The following proposed rule amendments are for the Commission to consider and submit for publication to the Office of Administrative Rules. The amended rules will be published in the Utah State Bulletin on July 1, 2026 and the mandatory public comment period will end on July 31, 2026.

1. R861-1A-32. Mediation Process Pursuant to Utah Code Section 63G-4-102.
R861-1A-32 outlines the requirements for mediation within state agency action under the Utah Administrative Procedures Act. The rule amendment requires that when a party participates in mediation to settle an appeal, the person must have authority to settle and also participate in good faith.

MOTION: Commissioner Deeds moved to submit the proposed amendments to R861-1A-32. Mediation Process Pursuant to Utah Code Section 63G-4-102. to the Office of Administrative Rules for publication in the Utah State Bulletin.

Commissioner Rockwell took a roll call vote and the motion passed unanimously

2. R865-19S-43. Sales to or by Religious and Charitable Institutions Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. Section 59-12-104. Last session, the Legislature passed 2026 S.B. 276, Veteran Organization Amendments, sponsored by Senator Ann Millner. The bill allows an entity that is exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501(c)(3) or (19) of the Internal Revenue Code to claim an exemption from Utah sales and use tax as a religious or charitable institution. To reflect the changes in SB 276, the rule amendment expands the sales and use tax exemption to include an organization recognized by the Internal Revenue Service under Section 501(c)(19) of the Internal Revenue Code. The amendment also makes technical updates to the rule language.

MOTION: Commissioner Deeds moved to submit the proposed amendments to R865-19S-43. Sales to or by Religious and Charitable Institutions Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. Section 59-12-104. to the Office of Administrative Rules for publication in the Utah State Bulletin.

Commissioner Rockwell took a roll call vote and the motion passed unanimously
