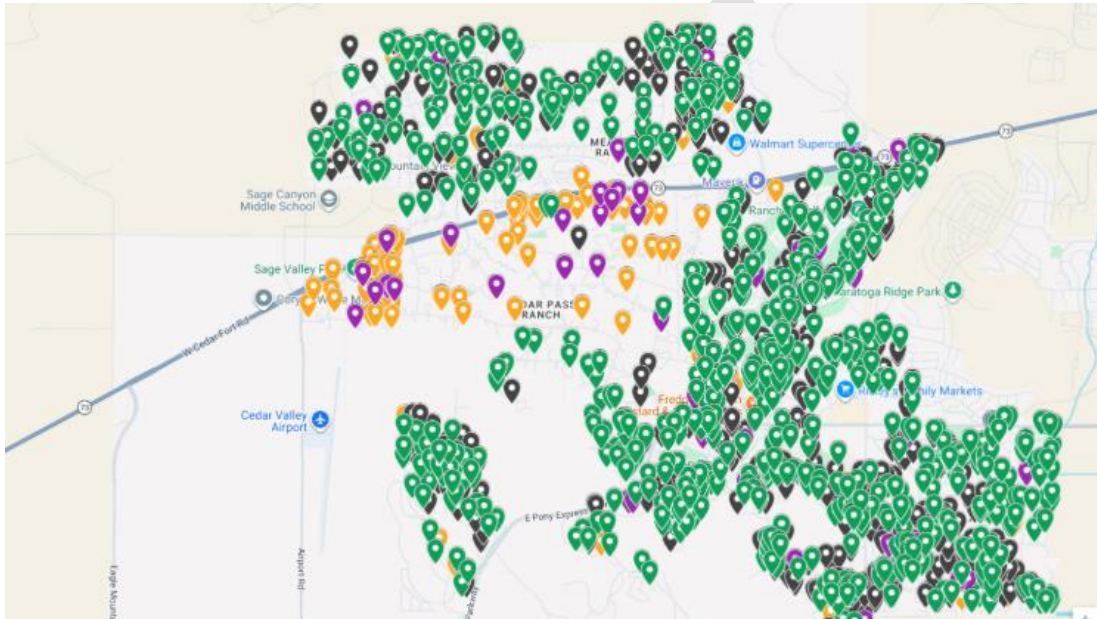
2. REVIEW THE JUNE 23, 2026 PRIMARY ELECTION SUMMARY REPORT

Aaron R. Davidson *(Utah County Clerk)*

Reported that the elections went well and the participation rate was 27%.

There were small improvements with the cure process.

Several people in Eagle Mountain, precincts 7 and 10, called the Election office reporting that they had not received a ballot. The Clerk's Office is currently in contact with the US Postal Service and the print vendor. Many of the voters received a notification or informed delivery on June 3 from the USPS that their ballot was in the mail. Something happened between Salt Lake City and Eagle Mountain with delivery. All ballots have been accounted for by the print vendor, were mailed, and have timestamps to Salt Lake City. The Clerk's office has been in contact with the investigative arm of the USPS but do not have answers as of yet. Commissioner Beltran said he didn't want to let this go and would like some answers.
