1. Annual URS Public Safety Pickup Election Form. Staff Contact: Dawn Brecke

Staff Introduction:

Ms. Brecke provided an overview of the annual Utah Retirement System (URS) requirements, addressing the increase in contribution rates and the rationale for the Town of Springdale's continued participation in the employer pickup election. She provided the number of Tier 1 and Tier 2 public safety employees.

Council Questions:

Mr. Burns asked if the dollar amount was about \$45 per pay period. Ms. Brecke commented that it was not very much.

Pat Campbell made the motion that the Town Council approves and certifies the Town of Springdale's continued election under the Utah Retirement System Tier 2 public safety and

firefighter contributory retirement system. To pick up the required employee contribution for Tier 2 public safety members for the fiscal year 2026-27 rate of 5.98% of eligible compensation, effective July 1, 2026, and authorizes submission of the employer election to pick up member contribution form to the URS. Randy Aton seconded the motion.

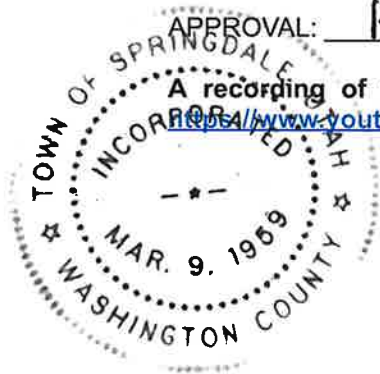
