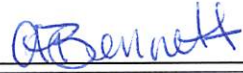

1. Public Comments a. Invitation to public present for matters to be brought before Council b. Public Hearing on Ordinance 2026-6 Annexing property and extending town boundaries for Vearl Christiansen's property c. Public Hearing on Fiscal Year 2027 Budget	Mayor Good opened the floor for public comments. Residents expressed concern about curb and gutter needing fixed, and ADA ramp as well as cross walk signage along the new safe path connect on Hwy 137. Mayor Good opened the public hearing regarding Ordinance 2026-6 annexing the Vearl Christiansen property into the Mayfield Town boundaries. No public comments were received. Mayor Good closed the public hearing. Mayor Good opened the public hearing on the proposed Fiscal Year 2027 Budget. No public comments were received. Mayor Good closed the public hearing.	
2. Council Discussion & Action Items a. Paul Atwood- Request for crosswalk signs b. Review and approval of Ordinance 2026-6 Annexing Certain Real Property c. Review and approval of Resolution 2026-F	Paul Atwood addressed the Council regarding pedestrian safety and requested additional crosswalk signage within Town. Council discussed several possible locations and agreed that improving visibility at designated crossings would enhance pedestrian safety. Staff was directed to continue working with UDOT where appropriate and evaluate additional signage options. The Council reviewed the proposed annexation ordinance incorporating the Vearl Christiansen property into the Town boundaries. Discussion included the Planning Commission's recommendation and compliance with statutory annexation requirements. Approval of Fiscal Year 2027 Budget d. Review and approval of Resolution 2026-G Amending Fiscal Year 2026 Budget e. Review of draft updates to Accessory Building ordinance f. Discussion and approval of 2026 Grand Marshals for 24th of July event	Council reviewed the proposed Fiscal Year 2027 Budget. Discussion included projected revenues and expenditures, anticipated capital improvements, and ongoing operating costs. A motion was made to adopt Resolution 2026-F approving the Fiscal Year 2027 Budget. The Council reviewed proposed amendments to the Fiscal Year 2026 Budget to reflect adjustments made throughout the fiscal year. A motion was made to adopt Resolution 2026-G amending the Fiscal Year 2026 Budget. Council continued reviewing proposed revisions to the Accessory Building Ordinance. Discussion focused on Planning Commission recommendations, setbacks, and improving ordinance language for clarity while maintaining neighborhood compatibility. Staff was directed to continue refining the ordinance before bringing it back for further consideration. Council discussed nominations for the 2026 July 24th Grand Marshals. After discussion, 3 options were made. A motion was made to select Les and Darlene Bogh to serve as the 2026 Grand Marshals in recognition of their service and contributions to the community. Mayor Good noted that the Sheriff's Office has continued conducting speed enforcement within Town. Council Member Wilber reported on ongoing public works activities and discussed current maintenance projects. Council Member Medler provided an update on Gunnison Valley Recreation Board and community baseball activities.
