

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF WALLSBURG TOWN, UTAH, PROHIBITING THE USE OF IGNITION SOURCES, OPEN FLAMES, AND FIREWORKS IN WALLSBURG TOWN

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Wallsburg Town, Utah, in alignment with the State of Utah and Wasatch Fire District have the desire to reduce the threat of wildfires, which may cause extensive damage and economic hardship within the Town; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code 15A-5-202.5 and Wasatch Fire District Code, when the County Fire Marshal determines that existing or historically hazardous environmental conditions necessitate controlled use of an ignition source in mountainous, brush-covered, forest-covered, dry grass-covered, and wildland urban interface areas, as well as areas near waterways, trails, canyons, washes, ravines, or similar areas; and

WHEREAS, the County Fire Marshal has determined that existing hazardous environmental conditions, increased fine fuel loading, rising temperatures, along with the forecasted weather data and dropping fuel moisture content of live and dead vegetation, necessitate controlled use of ignition sources throughout the Town, which is entirely made up of the above identified areas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF WALLSBURG TOWN, UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

Unless explicitly approved through the issuance of a written permit, the Wallsburg Town Council prohibits the use of any ignition source, including open flames and fireworks, throughout the Wallsburg Town municipal boundaries effective Friday June 26th until conditions improve and the State of Utah and/or Wasatch Fire District lifts restrictions.
