

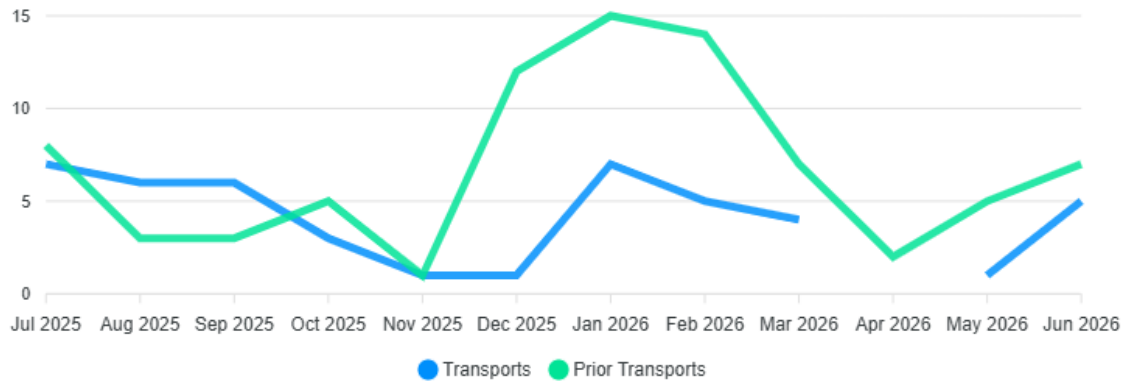

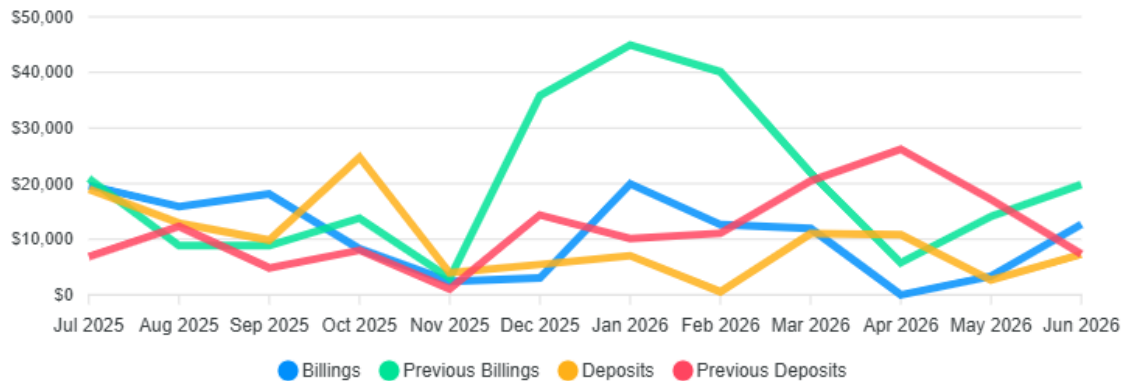

Notes

Exposure

The Iron Fire Occupational Exposure Notice advises five North Fork Firefighters who worked on the Iron Fire near Eureka, Utah, between June 19 and June 25, 2026, that they may have experienced potential exposure to lead and other heavy metals from historic mining areas, including the Eureka Mills Superfund Site and surrounding Tintic Mining District. While the risk of significant exposure is considered low and depends on activities that disturbed contaminated soil or dust, responders should retain the notice as part of their occupational health record, report any suspected work-related exposure through their agency's reporting process, clean all clothing, vehicles, and equipment using wet cleaning methods, and seek medical evaluation if they develop symptoms consistent with heavy metal exposure.

Ready, Set, Go

Ready, Set, Go! is a nationally recognized wildfire preparedness program that helps residents living in wildfire-prone areas prepare for and respond to wildfire threats. Ready means creating defensible space around homes, developing an evacuation plan, and assembling emergency supplies before fire season. Set means staying informed, monitoring fire conditions, and being prepared to leave at a moment's notice when a wildfire threatens. Go means evacuating immediately when directed by emergency officials or when conditions become unsafe, taking only essential items and following designated evacuation routes. The program emphasizes that early preparation and timely evacuation are the best ways to protect lives and reduce the impacts of wildfires.

Minor Accident

Engine 211 was involved in a minor contact incident with a Utah Highway Patrol (UHP) patrol vehicle on Highway 189. The incident resulted in only a small scratch on Engine 211, and both vehicles sustained very minor cosmetic damage that does not require repairs. Based on the circumstances, I do not anticipate any further action will be necessary. As a precaution, additional driver training will be provided to reinforce safe vehicle operations and help prevent similar incidents in the future.
