MEETING MINUTES

1. Board Members unanimously approved March 12, 2026, Minutes. Motion by Board Member Olson, second by Board Member McGary.

NEW BUSINESS

2. Board Member David Harris and City Manager Norm Beagley introduced Kami Ellsworth, New Community Services Director
3. Event Coordinator Ivan Mangum shared updates regarding upcoming community events.
 - a. Hometown Market – Will be held Monday nights, June 15, June 29, July 13, July 27, and August 10 – information provided and promoted through social media and City Webpage. Two roads will be blocked to help secure area and control traffic
 - b. My Hometown Santaquin – Days of Service. June 13, July 18, August 15 and Sept 12. Participants will meet at the LDS church building on 300 w. The first Days of Service event was held May 2, 2026, and had a good turnout. City Manager Norm Beagley discussed the Community Resource Center offered by My Hometown and the classes and activities offered.
 - c. America 250 Celebration – on July 1, 2026, Appreciation night with guest speaker Utahna Wentz. Awards will be given to the winners of the essay and art contests. No exact number of submissions was given. June 6, 2026, possible Quilt Creation booth at Family Fitness Fest. Currently looking for a volunteer to help with the quilt creation. Ivan Mangum asked board members for any recommendations for a volunteer. Hometown Market held on June 29, 2026, with be America 250 themed. City Manager Norm Beagley gave updates on the statewide America 250 celebration. Council Member Sara Olson asked for details regarding the Nation-Wide America 250 Potluck. A discussion was had regarding

Santaquin City not hosting a Potluck event but encouraging community members to get together and celebrate individually with family, neighbors and friends.

- d. Board Member Cam McGary asked if the Orchard Days 5k was part of the run series where runners can earn a piece of a puzzle medal. Board members are hearing positive feedback from the community. Next run event will be held on June 6, 2026, at the Family Fitness Fest.
4. City Manager Norm Beagley gave an update on Santaquin City being redesignated as Healthy Utah, Healthy Santaquin for another three years. Encouraging our community to be healthier and have a better quality of life.
