

RESOLUTION NO. 30-2026

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN WEBER FIRE DISTRICT AND ROY CITY FOR TEMPORARY STAFFING ASSISTANCE AND OPERATIONAL CREW EXCHANGES; AUTHORIZING THE BOARD CHAIR TO SIGN SUCH AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

SECTION 1. RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Weber Fire District (the "District") is a Local District created as a Service Area, a body politic and subdivision of the State of Utah, authorized to provide fire protection, emergency medical, rescue, and related public safety services within its jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, the District and Roy City recognize the importance of regional cooperation in maintaining effective fire protection and emergency medical services and desire to strengthen operational coordination between their respective organizations; and,

WHEREAS, the District and Roy City have negotiated a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") establishing procedures for temporary staffing assistance and operational crew exchanges to improve emergency response readiness, personnel familiarity, and organizational coordination; and,

WHEREAS, the MOU provides a framework for voluntary temporary staffing assignments during personnel shortages, establishes reimbursement procedures for those assignments, and creates a voluntary crew exchange program intended to familiarize personnel with each agency's stations, apparatus, equipment, response areas, and operational procedures in anticipation of future cooperative operations; and,

WHEREAS, the MOU provides that personnel assigned under the agreement shall remain employees of their home agency, establishes command, supervision, liability, workers' compensation, scheduling, reimbursement, and administrative responsibilities, and preserves all governmental immunities provided by law; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that entering into this Memorandum of Understanding promotes firefighter safety, improves operational readiness, enhances regional cooperation, and supports the orderly integration of personnel and operations for the benefit of the communities served by both agencies; and,

WHEREAS, the Board Chair is the authorized official of the District for purposes of executing agreements and related documents of this nature;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES THAT,

The Board of Trustees of the Weber Fire District hereby approves the Memorandum of Understanding between Weber Fire District and Roy City for Temporary Staffing Assistance and Operational Crew Exchanges, attached hereto as **Attachment A** and incorporated herein by this reference, and authorizes the Board Chair to execute said Memorandum of Understanding and any related documents necessary to implement the agreement on behalf of the District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 2. REPEALER OF CONFLICTING ENACTMENTS:

All orders and resolutions with respect to the changes herein enacted and adopted which have heretofore been adopted by the District, or parts thereof, which are in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution, are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not be construed to revive any act, order or resolution, or part thereof, heretofore repealed.

SECTION 3 - PRIOR RESOLUTIONS:

The body and substance of any and all prior Resolutions, together with their specific provisions, where not otherwise in conflict with this Resolution, are hereby reaffirmed and readopted.

SECTION 4 - SAVINGS CLAUSE:

If any provision of this Resolution shall be held or deemed to be or shall, in fact, be invalid, inoperative or unenforceable for any reason, such reason shall not have the effect of rendering any other provision or provisions hereof invalid, inoperative or unenforceable to any extent whatever, this Resolution and the provisions of this Resolution being deemed to be the separate independent and severable act of the Board of Trustees of the Weber Fire District.

SECTION 5. DATE OF EFFECT:

This Resolution shall be effective on the 14th day of July, 2026, and after publication or posting as required by law.
