CITIZEN COMMENTS

Scott Pugh – glad we still have a town. Thanked the Mayor, Sheriff's Office, Fire teams, and EMS. Marc Rowley – Thanked the City for keeping the fire department in water. Appreciated the Mayor, Tyler and towns people for all their support. Council Members Davis and Clements also expressed their thanks and gratitude.

DISCUSSION ITEMS/ACTION ITEMS

Interim Sheriff, Travis Kenison, Emergency Procedures.

A lot of gratitude from the Sheriff's Office to the community. It was amazing to see the community come together during the evacuation. He thanked the Fire Department for their hard work and the EMS who were tasked with things they normally don't handle. He hopes we will all learn and grow from this experience.

Shay Morrison, Community Advisor – State of Emergency, Emergency Procedures.

He clarified a couple of funding items. He thinks it would be good for someone with the Forest Service or BLM to come and talk about reseeding.

Drake Underwood - Juab Emergency Manager commented there will a meeting with the State on Monday to go over the different funding avenues. He had one of the Juab Search & Rescue members reach out to him about donating a cement truck full or sand that will fill about 800 bags. The Sheriff's Office will be bringing out their sandbagging machines along with about

5000 bags. Mayor Jenkins said Santaquin wanted to help and they brought up six truckloads of sand. Council Member Davis offered to use his skid steer to move the sandbags.

Emergency Declaration.

Mayor Jenkins asked for a vote. Council Member Clements made a motion to accept the Mayor's Emergency Declaration. Council Member Maxfield seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken all in favor motion carried.

Discussion/Action concerning Governor Spencer Cox Executive order on Fireworks.
The Council was in favor of upholding the Governor's Executive Order on Fireworks.

Council Member Maxfield made a motion to accept the resolution to set the Certified Tax Rate. Council Member Davis seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken all in favor motion carried.

Discussion/Action concerning Water Restrictions.
No action was taken. Recorder Bigler reiterated what the current restrictions are. The North side of town can do outside watering on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. The South side of town can do outside watering on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday. There is no watering allowed on Sunday. This information is available on the city website.

Recreation Committee – The Rec Committee would like to hold a Eureka Strong celebration on July 18th. This event would be paid for by donations. Mayor Jenkins would like to have the Fire Department and Sheriff's Office invited. The Rec Committee would like to have a meeting with the Mayor and Recorder Bigler on Thursday at 5:00 pm concerning communication between the Rec Committee and the City Office. With the passing of the emergency declaration will there be any relief for the small businesses here in town. Mayor Jenkins said the businesses will need to turn in paperwork showing their losses during the evacuation.

Council Member Raeleen Maxfield – For the most part the water and sewer are in a good spot. Rural Water will be sending some people up to look at them. She said a lot of what is left is getting the documents put together. She said overall she thinks we can improve and learn from this experience. Council Member Davis said he appreciates all the work she did. He feels it is important to bring the mistakes to the forefront. She agreed but said it should be handled in a positive manner.

Council Member Tony Atherley – Absent
