

Overview of the South Weber City General Plan Amendment Process

The proposed General Plan amendment process is intended to provide opportunities for policy discussion, public participation, and review by both the Planning Commission and City Council before adoption.

1. Joint Planning Commission and City Council Work Session

Conduct a joint work session to review the proposed General Plan amendments, discuss policy direction, identify key issues, and receive preliminary input from both bodies. *(Completed June 9, 2026)*

2. Planning Commission Discussion and development of draft amendments. *(Initial discussion June 11, 2026, meetings ongoing)*

3. Open House

Public review draft amendments, Q&A with staff and Planning Commissioners during evening hours at City Hall.

4. Planning Commission Public Hearing

Hold a Planning Commission public hearing to receive public comments on the proposed amendments and consider input from residents, stakeholders, and interested parties.

5. Planning Commission Deliberation and Recommendation

Following the public hearing, the Planning Commission will deliberate on the proposed amendment(s), make any desired modifications, and forward a formal recommendation to the City Council.

6. City Council Review and Adoption

The City Council will review the Planning Commission's recommendation, make any revisions it deems appropriate, conduct any required public hearing(s), and consider adoption of the General Plan amendments by resolution.
