Review of 2026-2027 Original Draft Budget Adoption

Mayor Paul Penrod explained that this public hearing is for the 2026–2027 Original Draft Budget and invited all who wished to comment to come forward. Council Member Laurel Workman stated that she had requested some money for a youth council and asked whether it was budgeted in the miscellaneous section. Dave Oxman stated that some money can be moved for that purpose. He also explained that the budget has about a \$67,000 surplus. This money is tentatively allocated toward roads but can be used for another need if one arises.

Mayor Penrod opened the meeting up to the public.

Cory Madsen explained that he has been receiving pressure regarding 400 South between 500 and 700 East, so he will be obtaining bids to chip seal some roads.
