- No citizens asked to be heard.

Discussion items:

- Bike bus report out: 5 total weeks with growth each week with 40 plus kids at last ride. Possible second line for next year's school season.
- Colin reported on options the city is considering changing concerning current OHV speed limit signs. 15 OHV speed limits might not be held up in court, and all OHV may be allowed to use roads with current signage. A few options on table, one being to reduce all streets to 20 miles per hour. Asked for discussion. The consensus of the group is one 20 mph speed limit. Sands flat will keep the 15-mph speed limit for OHV as all OHV's are allowed on road.
- Work Wednesday report. Some new kiosks were installed and cemented in the ground. Pulled weeds along 500 west. No Work Wednesday will be scheduled for next month.
- Even reported and discussed the "Snotch" or "Notch" trail work options for eroded away trails. Improving the "Snotch" for walking down to keep the area free of congestion and safety. Coney Islands named portions will be changed for the ending connection and beginning connection.

Group report:

- GCATT: Trail Crews have finished working on the Navajo Rocks area and will be focusing next on the Jimmy Keen trail. They have a grant for a large maintenance event and will focus on the Pack Creek fire areas. Mud Springs phase 2 funding has been pushed to road improvements. They are now working on funding Phase 2b. Working with the State trail crews on the sovereign Single track moto trails. New signage is in the works to replace worn out signs.
- Forest service: Trail crews have been working in the Abajo Mountains and plan to move to Two-mile trails on the La Sal. planning stages or in process for a new portion of the "WE" trails system down from Warner Lake.
- National parks: White rim day use permitting has been moved online. Each biker in a group needs to get a permit. Working on signage for a new gate that is not extremely visible. White crack camp site improvements. September 1st to start

the Arches shuttle system. Arches had the highest Memorial Day visitors on record. Grand viewpoint overlook trail closed during week for improvements. No guidance on new OHV rules; they will be treated the same as currently enforced.

- BLM: Potash road construction (chip seal). 313 chip seal later this summer. Officially designating existing airstrips in Grand and San Juan counties.
- County commission: Arches shuttle system is a big lift to get started by the September 1st start date.
- Moab City: Still working on trail signage; 25 signs budgeted for this year. Moab City has placed money in the budget for intersection improvement. The city is working with the county at the lion's park boat ramp and looking at improvements along the south side of the river for access and recreation.
- Search and rescue: New Facebook page. Working with EMS crew at left hand for carry out practice.
- Sand Flats: visitor numbers still up from previous year. Repairing 4 x 4 trails. Sand Flats videos on YouTube and visitor center will host those on demand. An electric motorcycle blew up in the "hot tube" trail obstacle.
- Running: no new running events. Run club Tuesday and Saturday morning.
- Secretary: Large BLM area parking wanted at Bar-M for NICA events. Group working on documents to get on future agenda for considerations.
- Biking Rep.: Rock Stacker section needs some trail crew work. Visitors have mentioned getting confused about the Bar-M Trail loop and current signage may need to be looked at.
- Equestrian: grant application for parking lot at Sand Island was denied. They have adopted the Burel Friends trail for maintenance.
- At Large: Funding is in place for bridge abutments for the trail the crosses Pack Creek between Main Street and Kane Creek Blvd. Street sweeping of Spanish Valley drive will be done twice a year by the county road department.
- Steward Moab: Trail ambassadors will be on break until fall season.
