WHEREAS, Taylorsville City has received a charitable donation in the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) from Ms. Glenda K. Seelos; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Seelos has designated that the donation be used to support improvements at the Taylorsville Senior Center, including the purchase of a new stove and replacement chairs for the benefit of the residents who utilize the facility; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the donation serves a valid public purpose by enhancing the quality, safety, and functionality of the Taylorsville Senior Center for the enjoyment and benefit of the community's senior citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to formally accept this generous gift on behalf of the residents of Taylorsville City and to express its sincere appreciation for Ms. Seelos' remarkable generosity and civic spirit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TAYLORSVILLE CITY, UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Acceptance of Gift. The City Council hereby gratefully accepts the charitable contribution of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) from Ms. Glenda K. Seelos for the purpose of improving the Taylorsville Senior Center, including the purchase of a new stove and replacement chairs, consistent with the donor's expressed intent.

Section 2. Expression of Appreciation. The City Council extends its heartfelt gratitude and appreciation to Ms. Glenda K.
