Operators Report: The board discussed grease trap conditions and the rating system. Nolan Robertson told the board that he would not give a "poor" rating unless the manager approved it and he would get a sludge-judge reading at that point. The board held a short discussion on the Homestead grease traps and Nolan asked Wes Johnson to get a list of grease traps currently installed at the Homestead. There was also a discussion held regarding putting photos of the grease traps on the GIS system along with other data entry and training on the GIS. Becky Wood will contact Jarom Hlebasko at Sunrise Engineering to work out how to make GIS edits for the grease traps.

Department Reports:

Engineer Report: Wes Johnson updated the board on the monthly flows, discussed daily flow rates, infiltration studies and cleaning bids/RFP's.

Manager Report: Becky Wood updated the board on district projects and upcoming events noting a District Blood Drive on July 27 at the city offices. The board discussed the Kohler Property Annexation Agreement sewer conditions submitted to the city. Wes Johnson discussed the Jordanelle SSD and MSD contract and capacity issues. Craig Simons gave an update from the Sewer Summit meeting held with local officials earlier that day.
