7474 E. 200 S., 10:15 a.m.**

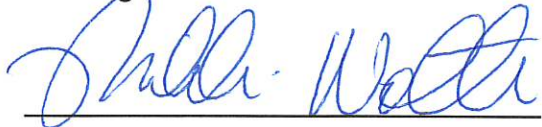
The Work Session was scheduled to discuss traffic solutions for 100 S.

Attending: Mayor Richard Sorensen, TCM Bruce Ahlstrom, TCM Jim Truett, TCM Lewis Johnson, TCM Sandy Hunter, Shannon Smith-Clerk, Rex Harris, Ashley Klase- Forest Service, Lt Jeffries, Golden Barrett- Weber Fire District, Andrea Dangerfield- Huntsville Parking Enforcement

This discussion focused on addressing traffic and access issues at Cemetery Point, particularly during peak weekends and the upcoming Fourth of July holiday. Mayor Richard Sorenson, Councilmember Jim Truett, and other officials met with Ashley from the Forest Service, law enforcement representatives, and URC (concessionaire) to discuss current challenges and potential solutions. The group reviewed recent traffic management efforts, including moving the toll booth to 6800 E. and having Andrea direct traffic, though concerns were raised about her safety and the need for better support.

They discussed various options for improving traffic flow, including electronic messaging signs, off-duty officer coverage, and potential long-term infrastructure improvements to create a bypass lane around the toll booth area. The conversation also covered emergency services access issues and the possibility of seeking federal or state funding for traffic improvements, with participants noting that previous attempts to secure funding had been unsuccessful due to bureaucratic challenges with the Forest Service.
