AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CHAPTER 1-12, GENERAL APPEAL PROCEDURE, TO TITLE 1 OF THE HUNTINGTON CITY CODE; AMENDING SECTION 3-1-15, REVOCATION OR DENIAL OF BUSINESS LICENSE, TO PROVIDE APPEAL RIGHTS; ADDING SECTION 3-1-18, ADMINISTRATIVE REINSTATEMENT FEE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Huntington City has adopted a municipal code governing the operation of the City and exercising its legislative powers through ordinances as provided in Utah Code §§ 10-3-701 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that business license applicants and licensees shall be afforded an appeal process for redress for denial, modification, suspension, or revocation of a business license; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City to establish an administrative hearing officer as the appeal authority for such matters pursuant to Utah Code § 10-3-1106; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the City should establish a general administrative appeal procedure for city actions unless specific appeal procedures are provided elsewhere in City code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that an Administrative Reinstatement Fee should be established to recover administrative costs associated with reinstating business licenses; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Huntington City, Utah, considered and approved the proposed amendments on July 15, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that adoption of this ordinance is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Huntington City;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Huntington City, Utah, that Ordinance No. O-2027-2 adopts Chapter 1-12, General Appeal Procedure, of the Huntington City Code; amends Section 3-1-15 regarding business license denial, modification, suspension, or revocation and appeal rights; adds Section 3-1-18 establishing an Administrative Reinstatement Fee; and provides for an effective date.
