



## RESOLUTION NO. R-26-15

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF GARLAND CITY, UTAH,  
APPOINTING Angela Johnson TO FILL A VACANCY ON THE  
GARLAND CITY COUNCIL PURSUANT TO UTAH CODE § 20A-1-510.**

**WHEREAS**, a vacancy occurred in the office of Garland City Council Member, upon the resignation of Sharla Nelson, effective 5/12/26; and

**WHEREAS**, Utah Code § 20A-1-510 authorizes the municipal legislative body to fill a vacancy in a municipal office by appointment following public notice, candidate solicitation, and interviews conducted in an open public meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, Garland City provided the public notice required by Utah law, identifying the vacancy, the qualifications for office, the procedure for submitting applications, and the date, time, and place at which the vacancy would be considered; and

**WHEREAS**, Garland City received applications from qualified individuals seeking appointment to the vacant office; and

**WHEREAS**, the Garland City Council conducted interviews of all qualified applicants in an open public meeting in accordance with Utah Code § 20A-1-510; and

**WHEREAS**, following the interviews and voting procedures required by Utah law, the Garland City Council determined that Angela Johnson is qualified to serve as a member of the Garland City Council and should be appointed to fill the vacancy; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that appointing Angela Johnson is in the best interests of Garland City and its residents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF GARLAND CITY, UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:**

### Section 1. Appointment.

Pursuant to Utah Code § 20A-1-510, Angela Johnson is hereby appointed to fill the vacancy in the office of Garland City Council Member.

### Section 2. Term of Appointment.

The appointment shall become effective immediately upon administration of the oath of office. If required by Utah Code § 20A-1-510(2), the appointment shall serve as an interim appointment until the office is filled through the election process prescribed by state law and the elected successor is qualified and sworn into office.

If no election is required under Utah Code § 20A-1-510, the appointee shall serve the remainder of the unexpired term as provided by law.

Section 3. Oath of Office.

The City Recorder is authorized and directed to administer the oath of office and complete all filings and notifications required by Utah law.

Section 4. Severability.

If any provision of this Resolution is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

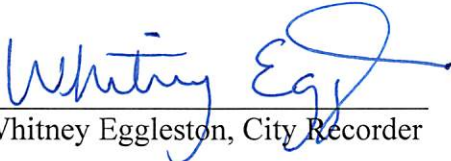

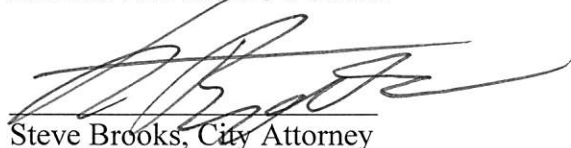
