Minutes of the Fox Hollow Golf Club Board of Directors Meeting held **June 18, 2026, at 6:00 p.m.** at the Fox Hollow Golf Club, 1400 North 200 East, American Fork, Utah.

1. Welcome

Clark welcomed everyone to the meeting.

2. Receive public comments.

There were no public comments.

3. Action Items

a. Review and approval of the May Finance Report.

JT explained most of the expenses were pro-shop expenditure. He noted other major expenditures were for gas or supplies for maintenance. He went over the budget, noting they had more than \$49,000 in revenues received than what was budgeted. He noted that membership was slightly down but all other revenues were up. In the year to date budget, they were \$227,000 more in revenue. He stated that May was a great month with the prepaid system and the tournaments starting.

Motion: Dave moved to approve the May Finance Report. Steve Chipman seconded the motion.

Vote: Those voting yes: Paulette Anderson, Steve Chipman, Max Powell, Johnny Revill, Dave Richards, and Clark Taylor. Those absent: Jay Fugal, Keely Giles, and Ryan Wood. The motion passed unanimously.

4. Operations Report

JT noted they were doing great, with June being one of their biggest tournament month. The tournaments that are usually in Cedar Hills are looking for place. He highlighted the city recreation camps. JT stated it was Abby's first year putting this on, and she did



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phenomenal! She is great with the kids and the women loved it. He stated the July 4th scramble registration has opened up. Next week they have the State Amateur Qualifier and then the Utah Junior Golf Association Junior Open.

JT stated they are still at 350 members. The target pace of play is 4 hours 19 minutes. They do have a few holes that are slow, 6 and 7, which are the two toughest on the front, as well as 16 and 18. He was happy with the pace of play with how busy they are. It was still busy with tournaments going on.

5. Superintendent Report on Grounds and Equipment

JT mentioned that John was at the US Open but would be back this weekend, but Jan Carlos would be out for a few weeks. The city was working well with them to make sure they have water; they have thrown wetting agent on there to help reduce water. They ended up ordering cutters to make sure the greens were rolled. They have done an amazing job keeping the greens in great condition. They don't have a lot of tournaments and will look at aerating.

6. Topics of Discussion

Clark stated they have been working on getting temporary bathrooms. JT stated he contacted Honey bucket; They are going to be getting back to him with the VIP station costs. They won't be able to put a permanent structure until they get the sewer lines figured out.

Clark asked if there were other items for the next agenda. JT stated they will have more information on the driving range.

It was noted they would have the next meeting on July 23rd.

7. Adjournment.

Dave moved to adjourn the meeting. Paulette seconded the motion. All were in favor.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:20 p.m.
