

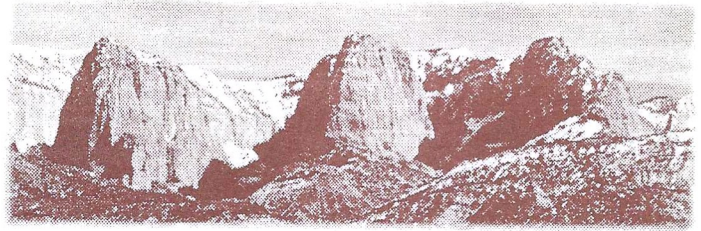
TOWN OF NEW HARMONY

1. Call to Order
2. Budget meeting rescheduled for June 8, 2026 at 7 p.m.
3. Minutes from May 6, 2026 read. Motion to accept as read made by Pace, 2nd by Larsen. Unanimous vote.
4. Sherise Woolsey – presented her house plans for a manufactured home to be installed on her lot on 100 South. Larsen advised her about the situation with the water table in that area. Motion to accept the plans made by Pace, 2nd by Batty. Unanimous vote.
5. Chris Peterson Concert – needing to have more money to be able to keep performing. Will need \$2,400.00 to be able to make ends meet. Larsen thinks it is a good thing for the town. Motion to give them the money made by Larsen, 2nd by Pace. Unanimous vote.
6. Wreaths Across America – Larsen represented Mr. Prince. Suggesting that the town do a one-time purchase of wreaths and no longer be involved with them. Motion to table this issue until next month made by Larsen, 2nd by Batty. Unanimous vote.
7. Reports – Pace – trees at the cemetery are coming back. Mayor told him that waterline will be going in for the Dutson property and will be connected to the cemetery while it is being installed.
