DISCUSSION ITEMS/ACTION ITEMS

Shay Morrison, Community Advisor.

CIB now has new requirements regarding all their applications. They must be sent to the AOG two weeks prior to the deadline, and they will be the ones to submit them. Incomplete applications will no longer be accepted. R6 is prioritizing 10 new items this fiscal year. He listed out the items. He will be focusing on those items this year.

Dan Fechner, Jones & DeMille.

He gave his report during the Work Meeting.

Boyce Sanderson.

He thanked everyone for helping out during the evacuations. He would like to discuss the Pie Hole – Pizza kitchen and the motel rooms. He passed out his proposal for the Pie Hole and motel. The proposal included drawings of the existing kitchen in the Gas Hole. He explained where it's located and what is already there. He showed them the changes he needed to make and why. He moved on to discuss what needs to be done to get the motel rooms up and running. He said he would get the necessary permits for both projects. Council Member Clements made a motion to accept his proposal. Council Member Nedreberg seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken all in favor motion carried.

SCADA Improvements: Discussion with Andrew Robinson (Full Spectrum).

Mr. Robinson didn't make it to the meeting. Mayor Jenkins commented they had issues with the SCADA system during the fire. We may need to get a generator to keep it running during power outages. We have been looking at making improvements to the cyber security on the system. We may need to look at getting some type of grant to help with the other improvements needed.

Post Fire Review – Discussion regarding recent fire events.

Request to Purchase 500 Gal. Fuel Cell to place on trailer, Repair/Replacement of fence at City Park.

They tabled talking about the fuel cell until after the Mayor goes and looks and the one a resident is offering to the city.

The Elks Lodge has volunteered the use of the empty space where Taylor's General store used to be. This space could be used by vendors.
