CANVAS OF THE JUNE 23, 2026 REPUBLICAN PRIMARY ELECTION .....1

Commissioner Robinson, Iron County Commission Chair, excused Commissioner Cozzens from today’s meeting. Ken noted that Nicole Rosenberg would be sitting in for Commissioner Cozzens.

Sam Woodall, Iron County Deputy Clerk, explained that under the Canvas of Elections, “If one of the county legislative bodies fails to attend, they shall replace the absent member by appointing, in this order, Treasurer, Assessor, and Sheriff,” UCA § 20A-4-301. Nicole Rosenberg is present as the Iron County Treasurer.

**CANVAS OF THE JUNE 23, 2026 REPUBLICAN PRIMARY ELECTION**

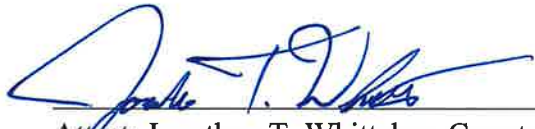
Jonathan Whittaker, Iron County Clerk, presented the Canvass of the June 23, 2026 Iron County Republican Primary Election. Jon explained that there were 21,379 active Republican voters and there was a 37.2% voter turnout. Counted Ballot Statistics: 7,943 total ballots counted. From that, 7,648 mail ballots were counted; 13 In-person early voting period ballots counted; 267 In-person Election Day ballots counted; 2 UOCAVA ballots counted, returned electronically; and 13 Provisional ballots counted. Jon noted that 2 voter affidavit envelopes were returned without ballots: one had the voting method HB300, and the other was a Misc. mail survey. Jon reported on the Provisional Ballot Statistics. There was a 92.9% of provisional ballots that were counted; 14 Provisional ballots issued; 13 Provisional ballots counted; 1 total provisional ballot not counted. He reported on the By-Mail Ballot Statistics: 78 total challenged curable ballots (number of voters sent a cure notice); 51 total rejected ballots that were curable but not cured; 18 envelopes with a signature that does not match the voter’s signature; 3 unsigned envelopes; and 30 ballots challenged for other curable reasons, which was 65.4% curable ballots not counted. There was 1 ballot where the voter submitted a disability affidavit, a total of 122 rejected non-provisional ballots that could not legally be cured; 121 ballots returned after the received-by deadline; 1 rejected ballot for other non-curable reasons, which was 0.2% of ballots returned as undeliverable.

Michael Bleak made a motion to approve the Canvas of the June 23, 2026 Iron County Republican Primary Election. Second by Nicole Rosenberg. Voting: Michael Bleak, Aye; Ken Robinson, Aye; Nicole Rosenberg, Aye.
