

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED TAX INCREASE WEBER
BASIN WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT
(Summit County Notice)**

The WEBER BASIN WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT is proposing to increase its property tax revenue.

The WEBER BASIN WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT tax on a \$1,895,000 residence would increase from \$194.90 to \$208.45, which is \$13.55 per year.

The WEBER BASIN WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT tax on a \$1,895,000 business would increase from \$354.37 to \$379.00, which is \$24.63 per year.

If the proposed budget is approved, WEBER BASIN WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT would receive an additional \$642,197 in property tax revenue from Summit County per year as a result of the tax increase. If the proposed budget is approved, WEBER BASIN WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT would increase its Summit County property tax budgeted revenue by 6.15% above last year's property tax budgeted revenue excluding eligible new growth.

The WEBER BASIN WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT invites all concerned citizens to a public hearing for the purpose of hearing comments regarding the proposed tax increase and to explain the reasons for the proposed tax increase. You have the option to attend or participate in the public hearing in person or virtually.
