Mr. Kirkpatrick will check with Mountain View one last time before other arrangements are made.

Mr. Kirkpatrick checked on a flyover for the program and it isn't possible that late in the year. Mr. Bybee suggested the commission make it an annual event for the Memorial Day Program. The City is willing to cover the cost of fuel.

Mr. Elwood asked about publicity. Mr. Bybee stated the event will be advertised by a direct mailer to Orem residents, placed on the City's Facebook page and website along with flyers and posters distributed throughout the City. Mr. Kirkpatrick suggested it be placed in the Daily Herald's community event portion of the paper. Mr. Bybee will make sure that takes place. Mr. Bybee will work with Ms. Downey to assure the flyers and posters are distributed.

Mr. Bybee has approved the purchase of two new speakers to help with the sound system. They have been purchased and will be ready for use at the event.

Mr. Kirkpatrick has two names of community members that are interested in serving on the commission. The commission does have two terms that will expire next year.

Mr. Kirkpatrick doesn't feel there is a need for another meeting this month.
