Matters for Discussion

1. Parks and recreation Master Plan.

Urban Design Director, Sharen Hauri, introduced Part 3 of the Parks and Recreation Master Plan. Ms. Hauri recapped the previous presentation. Part 1 presented what City has; Part 2 presented the benefits of having parks, open spaces and Recreation Centers. Part 3 presented what future goals to acquire more parks, open spaces, trails and community centers. The presentation focused on parks due to the amount of information contained in the Master Plan. A future meeting will be requested to present on open spaces and trails.

Ms. Hauri proceeded with her presentation on the Parks and Recreation Master Plan – Part 3. A copy of this presentation is attached and incorporated by this reference.

Ms. Hauri concluded her presentation and asked City Council Members for any questions. Ms. Hauri expressed her desire to come back to City Council Members with more of a breakdown of how this plan could look over time if broken down amongst the different tools.


Ms. Hauri clarified that this is now a policy decision on how much the Council wants open spaces and parks, how much they would like to pay for it, and how willing they are to ask every resident to pay for it. Ms. Hauri explained that new residents will pay for it when they buy a new home or apartment; old residents will pay for it, if they want to have additional open space or fill in those gaps. There is going to be something coming out of the residents' pockets or the City's General Fund that will not go towards something else.

Council Chair Irvin Jones directed Council Members to email any questions to Ms. Hauri and copy the rest of the Council on those emails so that everyone stays informed.
