Reporting Requirement Standards and 18-Month Timeline for New Education Data Collections	We request statutory amendments to Utah Code establishing a standardized framework for public education data mandates. Operationalizing Recommendations #1, #3, and #5 of the State Board's Reporting Requirements Study (Utah Code § 53E-3-526), this request creates new statutory provisions to: 1. Establish a standard 18-month minimum implementation timeline before new data collections are enforced. 2. Require LEA administrative burden and software vendor costs to consistently be evaluated and included on legislative fiscal notes. 3. Adopt a statutory reporting requirement evaluation process or matrix to screen proposed data collections during the drafting process. Update Statutory Language for APEX Grant Program	53E-10-310 was updated to refer to the newly updated APEX Grant Program statute (53F-5-224) but still refers to the Catalyst Center Grant Program (53E-10-310(1)(c)(ii) and 53E-10-310(2)(b)(ii)). These references should be updated to refer to the APEX Grant Program instead. In addition, when the name was changed to APEX, 53F-5-224(4)(a)(ii) was updated incorrectly.
