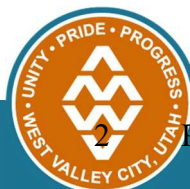

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A FINAL BUDGET; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SUPPORT OF WEST VALLEY CITY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2026 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2027; AND DETERMINING THE RATE OF TAX AND LEVYING TAXES UPON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN WEST VALLEY CITY, UTAH, TAXABLE BY LAW FOR THE YEAR 2026.

WHEREAS, the City Manager of West Valley City, as required by law, has submitted to the West Valley City Council a proposed budget (herein the “Interim Budget”) for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2027; and

WHEREAS, the City Council carefully reviewed, considered, revised and adopted the Interim Budget; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, a copy of the Interim Budget was placed on record in the City Recorder’s Office at the address indicated below for inspection by the general public during regular office hours; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, a public hearing to receive comment and consider adoption of the final budget (herein the “Budget”) was held on August 11, 2026, at 6:30 p.m., both electronically and in the City Council Chambers located at 3600 Constitution Boulevard, West Valley City, Utah; and

WHEREAS, the date, time and place of the hearing, the right of citizens to be heard, the summary of the Interim Budget, and the location of the City Recorder’s Office and availability of the Interim Budget for public inspection, were publicized as required by law; and

WHEREAS, citizens in physical or electronic attendance at the public hearing were permitted to provide written or oral comment for or against the Interim Budget, which also included Community Development Block Grant funds and other State and federal grants; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, the City has published the necessary notice and held the public hearings required prior to adopting the proposed property tax rate and setting the property tax levy; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and desire of West Valley City to comply with all applicable State and local laws regarding the adoption of the Budget, the adoption of the property tax rate and the levy of property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of West Valley City, Utah, hereby determines that it is in the best interests of the citizens of West Valley City to adopt the Budget for West Valley City, and determine the rate of tax and levy taxes upon all real and personal property within West Valley City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of West Valley City, Utah, as follows:

Section 1. Budget Adoption.

1. The amounts shown in Exhibit “A,” which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, are hereby appropriated for the corporate purposes and objects of West Valley City for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2027, and are hereby adopted as the Budget of West Valley City for the fiscal year 2026-2027.
2. Pursuant to law, a copy of the Budget for each fund within the Budget shall be certified by the Budget Officer and shall be filed with the State Auditor within 30 days after adoption of the Budget.
3. Pursuant to law, a certified copy of the Budget shall be filed in the office of the City Recorder and shall be available for public inspection during regular business hours.

Section 2. Tax Rate and Levy.

1. For the purpose of defraying the necessary and proper expenses of West Valley City, and for maintaining the government thereof, it is hereby determined that the rate of the general West Valley City property tax to be levied against all real and personal property within West Valley City taxable by law for the year 2026 is hereby set at .002694.
2. There is hereby levied upon all real and personal property within West Valley City taxable by law in the year 2026, for the fiscal year of West Valley City ending June 30, 2027, the tax rate as set forth above, on the taxable value of said property, to provide revenue for the West Valley City General Fund and for general City purposes.
3. As required by law, the rate set forth above and levied, along with all statements and information required by law, shall be reported to the Salt Lake County Auditor, the Utah State Auditor and to the Utah State Tax Commission.

Section 3. Further Action. In addition to the foregoing, the City Manager is hereby directed to implement any other necessary actions pertinent to the adoption of the Budget, the establishment of a tax rate, and the levy of property taxes. Such actions may include, but are not necessarily limited to, notification, reporting, and publishing as required by and consistent with applicable law.

PROPERTY TAX IMPACT STATEMENT

The approximate dollar amount of additional ad valorem revenue that would be generated by the proposed increase is **\$1,907,662**.

The approximate percentage increase in tax revenue based on the proposed tax increase is **5%**.

The approximate percentage increase to the amount of property taxes paid on an average residence per year as a result of the increase is **5%** or **\$32.71** per year.

The approximate percentage increase to the amount of property taxes paid on an average commercial property per year as a result of the increase is **5%** or **\$59.46** per year.

Cindy;

I got notice with my preliminary tax notice that WVC is considering a tax hike.

I can not attend the meeting due to my mobility issues, so I am listing my concerns for you to present at the meeting in my absence. I wasn't sure I could get to the council room for this meeting since WVC has locked down the building after the front doors and citizens can't get into any other area without an employee escort. This policy needs to be cancelled. The citizens of WVC are not "public enemy number one!"

1) I recognize that health insurance premiums continue to rise. The rank and file city employees will need a pay increase to at least cover the premium costs, but not the city manager.

2) I do not think the ordinance control department needs any more money for operations since they are not currently keeping the area between the curb and asphalt in front of my section of the city clear of weeds when the ordinance control officers can fine citizens when the weeds in their property are taller than 6 inches.

3) I tried to get information about whether my garbage would be emptied on Friday, July 24. The WVC website didn't list the dates that garbage would not be emptied by specific holidays. This website hasn't been changed since Dec. 2025. Get this website updated to show which holidays will not have garbage picked up.

4) I called the WVC office on Thur., July 23 to get my question about holiday garbage pickup answered, but the receptionist didn't know the answer. I was transferred to someone who was supposed to work in this department. but they never called me back that day or any other since. A list of holidays when garbage is not picked up should be a template for whoever answers the main city phone number. If I can't get my questions answered on this issue no more money needs to go to this department either.

The City is considering levying a tax rate that exceeds the City's certified tax rate. The proposed tax rate increase would generate approximately \$1,907,662 of additional ad valorem tax revenue to be used to pay for additional operational and employee compensation costs. The proposed tax rate increase would increase the City's ad valorem tax revenue by approximately 5%. If the City proceeds with the proposed tax rate increase, the City will provide notice of and conduct a public hearing, as required by Utah Code Section 59-2-919(4)(c).

PROPERTY TAX IMPACT STATEMENT

The approximate dollar amount of additional ad valorem revenue that would be generated by the proposed increase is **\$1,907,662**.

The approximate percentage increase in tax revenue based on the proposed tax increase is **5%**.

The approximate percentage increase to the amount of property taxes paid on an average residence per year as a result of the increase is **5%** or **\$32.71** per year.

The approximate percentage increase to the amount of property taxes paid on an average commercial property per year as a result of the increase is **5%** or **\$59.46** per year.

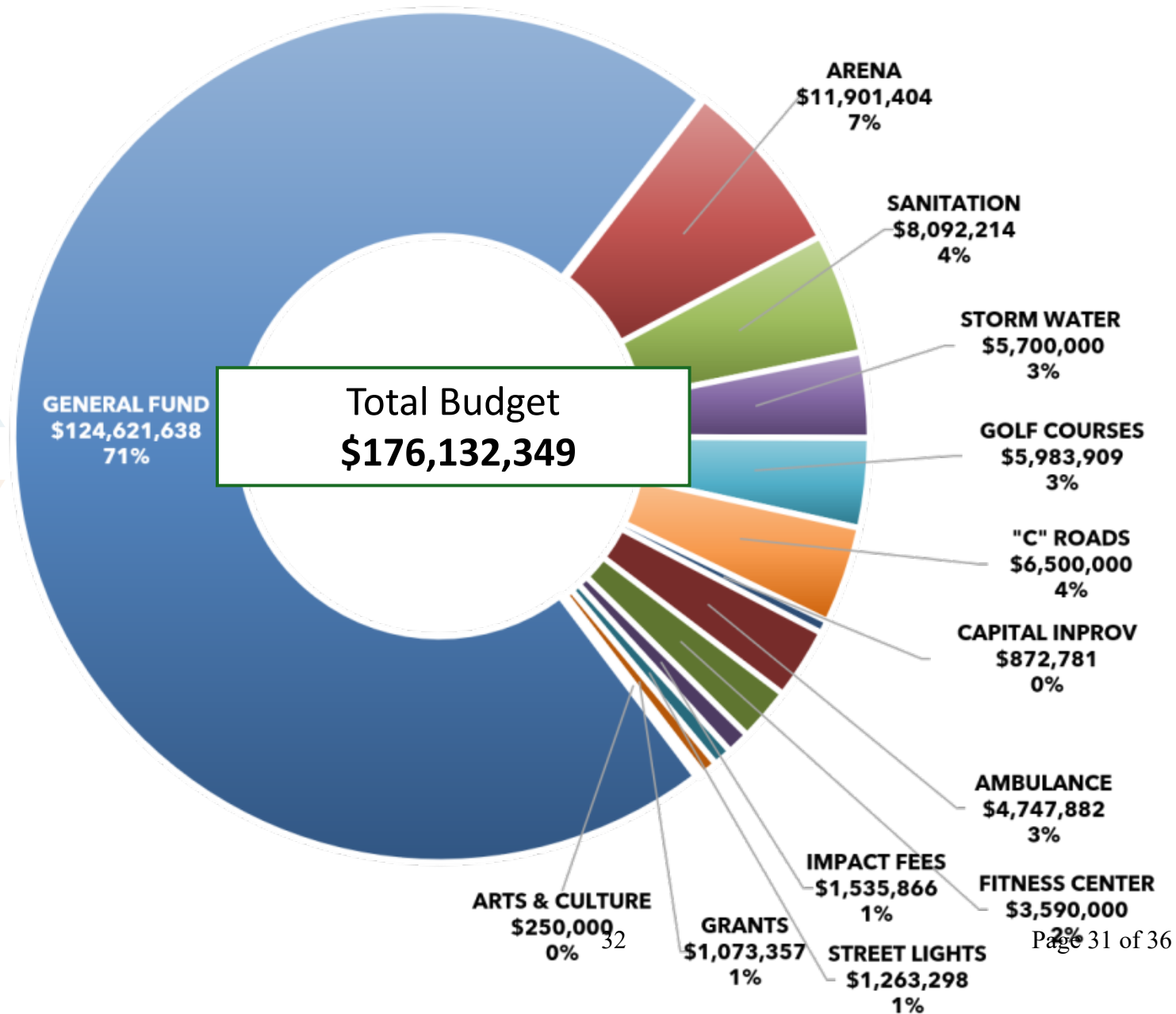

WEST VALLEY CITY TOTAL BUDGET *FY 2026-2027*



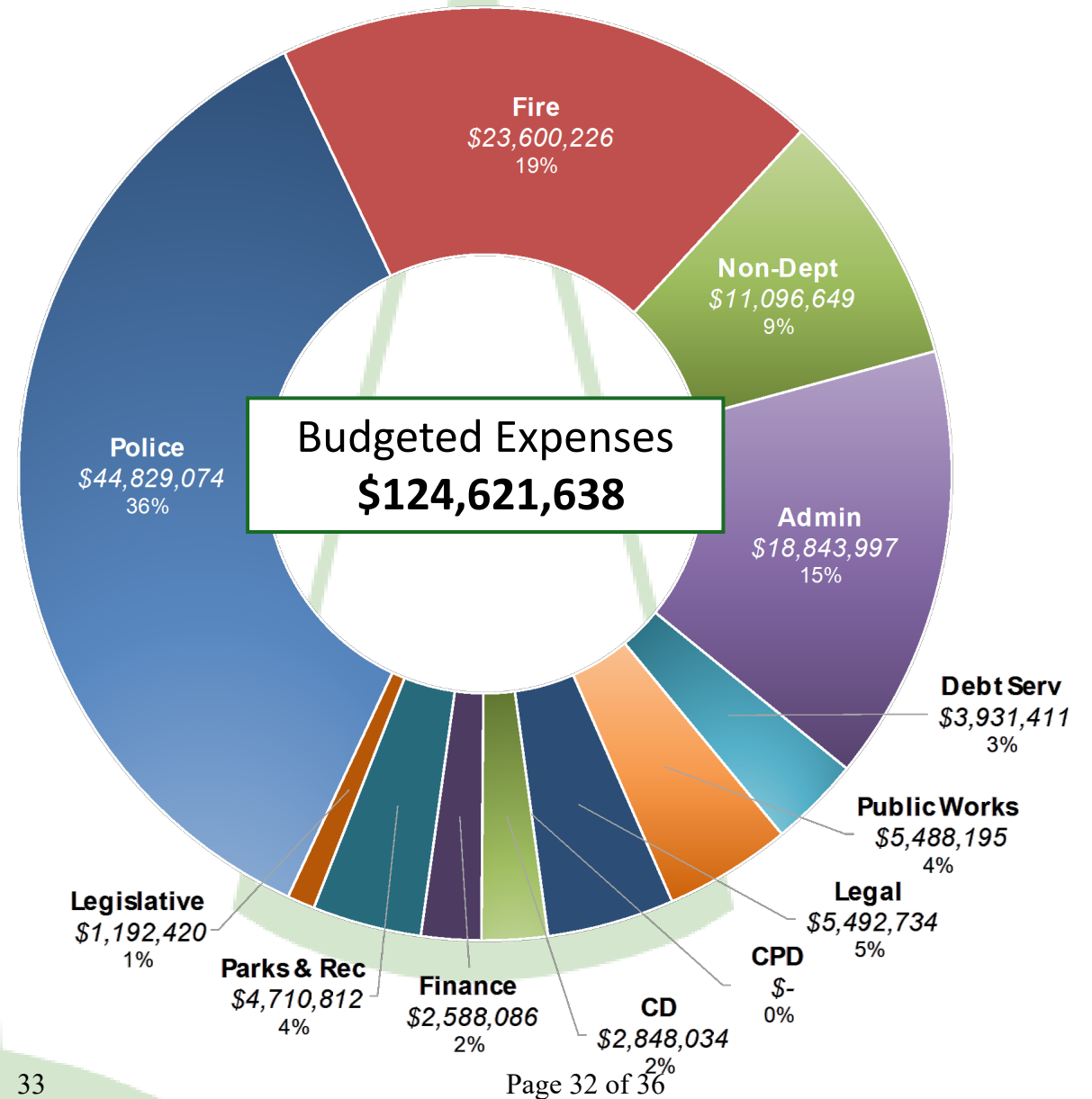
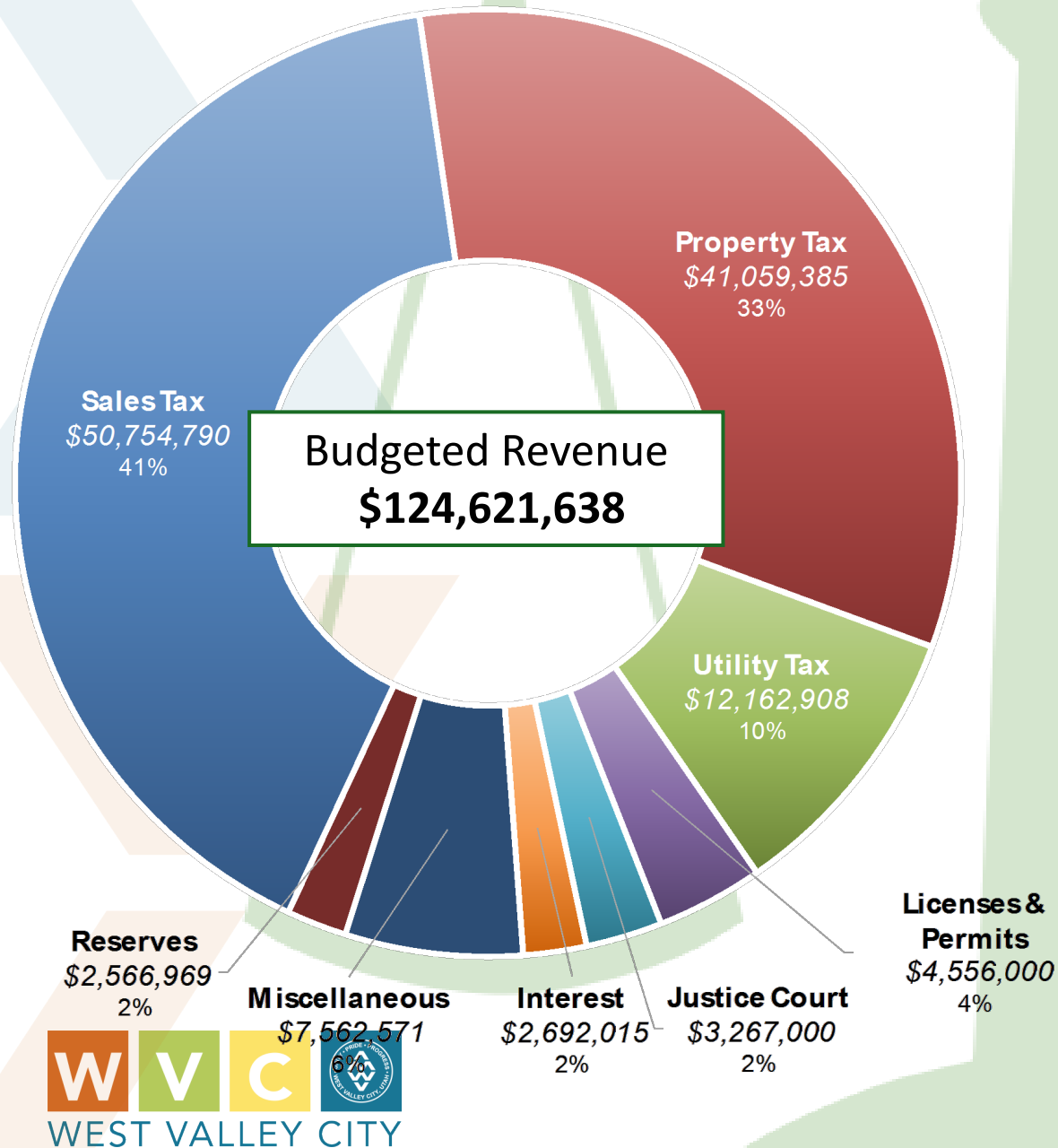

NOTICE OF PROPOSED TAX INCREASE WEST VALLEY CITY

The WEST VALLEY CITY is proposing to increase its property tax revenue.

The WEST VALLEY CITY tax on a \$456,000 residence would increase from \$643.05 to \$674.90, which is \$31.85 per year.

The WEST VALLEY CITY tax on a \$456,000 business would increase from \$1,169.18 to \$1,227.10, which is \$57.92 per year.

If the proposed budget is approved, WEST VALLEY CITY would receive an additional \$1,949,129 in property tax revenue per year as a result of the tax increase. If the proposed budget is approved, WEST VALLEY CITY would increase its property tax budgeted revenue by 4.93% above last year's property tax budgeted revenue excluding eligible new growth.
