

ORDINANCE NO. #26-0812-01

**AN ORDINANCE TO ACKNOWLEDGE THE ROCKVILLE BRIDGE
AS OWNED BY THE TOWN OF ROCKVILLE AND TO ADDRESS
PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES ON THE ROCKVILLE BRIDGE**

WHEREAS, the Town of Rockville owns the Historic Rockville Bridge crossing the Virgin River on Bridge Road; and

WHEREAS, the Rockville Town Council declares it is in the best interest of the public safety to address the potential severe safety hazards and serious injuries resulting from prohibited activities on the Bridge.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby ordained by the Rockville Town Council:

PROHIBITED AREAS & ACTIVITIES: It is illegal to climb, jump, swing, rappel, dive, drop or throw objects from the bridge or be on the ROCKVILLE BRIDGE structure performing these activities other than for maintenance by a licensed, contracted or Town authorized person. The intended use of the bridge is to provide safe passage over the Virgin River on the roadway surface only.

PENALTIES: Violations of this ordinance are subject to Utah State Code #76-6-206 and the potential penalties associated with such violation of criminal trespass.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately after passage and posting as required by law.
