VOLUNTEER & CONTRACT STAFF DRESS CODE

Volunteers/Contract Staff must be modestly dressed to be permitted to enter the facility. If there is any doubt in your mind about acceptable attire, don't wear it. The following apparel is **NOT** allowed in the prison:

- ❖ Shorts of any kind
- ❖ Dresses, skirts, or culottes must be knee length when standing and have no more than a five inch split; in the front, back or either side.
- ❖ Halter, tank or sun tops
- ❖ Excessive holes or worn items
- ❖ Sheer blouses or sheer clothing of any kind, or transparent or sheer clothing, including “burn-out” fabrics, yoga pants, or leggings
- ❖ Tight-fitting clothing (e.g. leggings, Jeggings, and spandex)
- ❖ Clothing fads that expose excessive amounts of skin, e.g. grunge, ripped, distressed, fatigued, destroyed, etc
- ❖ Wrap around blouses, dresses or skirts
- ❖ Blouses, dresses or tops that show any cleavage, come to the waist or show bare midriff
- ❖ Sleeveless blouses, dresses or tops
- ❖ Any clothing, which resembles inmate-issued clothing or staff-issued uniforms
- ❖ Camouflage-patterned items (e.g. military-type clothing or military fatigues)
- ❖ Attire displaying obscene/offensive, derogatory language or drawing
- ❖ Attire displaying gang association/ gang-related depiction
- ❖ Open toed shoes
