Sec. 15.02.010. Definitions.

Public service. ~~Uses, which may be housed in separate buildings, or which may occupy a space within a building, that are operated by a unit of government to serve public needs such as police (with jail), fire service, ambulance, post office, or judicial court.~~ A use operated by a governmental entity or nonprofit organization to provide public safety, administrative, judicial, postal, emergency, educational, social services, charitable, or other public-benefit services to the community.

(Yes, they just apply to Title 15.)

(Attorney would change it to "Public Uses")

(A public service is not the building itself; it is something we are providing to help the community. A public facility would be the building that houses the service(s).)

(Attorney recommended changing it to "Public Uses", the Definition Committee didn't feel that was necessary since it is only found in the definitions section and the definitions for the sign ordinance)

("Public Services" is found in the Public Facility section, on the allowed use table, and in the general provisions for Title 15)

("Public Use" is found once in the definitions for Public Street and Right-of-way)
