IV. Approval of Minutes

VIII. New Business

1. To review and adopt Ordinance 2026-07-16 an ordinance recommended by the Planning and Zoning Commission to amend Hinckley Town Code, Title 11. Land Use, Chapter 3. Zoning Districts, Section 4. Master Land Use Table.

The Council discussed the ordinance and that it cleans up and aligns the Master Land

Use Table with the Town Code and adds qualifier language where specific land uses are allowed with conditions.

IX. Outstanding Business

1. Park Pavilion Electricity

Council Member Skip Taylor is coordinating with Rocky Mountain Power to get power connected to the new park electrical service.

2. Celebration Planning

Council Member Skip Taylor will arrange for parade vehicles from Droubay Chevrolet.

Mayor Miller asked Kevin Morris to give the opening invocation at the park program.

The nine donated State Flags will be recognized and presented by the Youth City Council at the park program.

Due to the Firework ban, the morning salute is canceled for this year.

The parade sign ups will be at the rodeo grounds and the parade lineup will be along 400 N and 200 W. Dan and Delna Bliss will assist with the parade.

Celebration sponsor signs and street banners are ordered and ready for pickup in Salem. Council Member Chris Mork offered to pick them up.

Mosquito abatement will spray the park and rodeo grounds.

Council and staff will meet at the park Saturday morning at 7:00 AM for setup (canopies, games, vendor set up)

X. Miscellaneous Discussion

Council Member Skip Taylor inspected, serviced, and replaced parts on town backup generator (replaced propane hoses and new battery).

Council Members Skip Taylor and Chris Mork tested the backup generator at the town sewer lift stations:

300 N 150 W: The generator connects and works properly.

500 S Main Street: The electrical connector in the sewer lift station panel is

damaged/missing insulators; and a replacement part was ordered.

1000 W Center Street: This lift station is three phase. The generator had a blown relay; two replacement relays have been ordered for installation and re-testing.
