URC/ Community Clean Energy- We should be receiving a few more approved communication assets for distribution in the next few weeks. We did receive updated valuations and transmission studies for the projects that have made the short list. The valuations are better than before, but the transmission costs are more costly so we are looking into colocation which is battery storage. We are continuing to refine the opt out notices and all of the different formats that customers will receive. Working with RMP to refine how the \$4 is used to meet administrative costs and project costs.

Community Health Coalition- We met in July. We reviewed some of the options that are available through the 5 County AOG. Options for volunteering and receiving services are available to county residents. We are working on ideas that will help connect the community with resources. We took time to think through ideas for a grant available from Get Healthy Utah. We will be submitting our ideas soon.

Messaging- We held a workshop that tried to answer three questions; Should the project continue? How can we package the concept so that it is better understood by the community? If we continue, what values should be represented? There was a lot of great discussion, and we gathered quite a bit of information that we are reviewing. We are scheduled to meet later in the month.

Community Development- our new staff members are coming up to speed, and doing a great job of it. Eugenia is looking into grants for restoring the old jail.

I attended the 2 Cent event. I'm looking forward to hearing the ideas that residents suggested.
