

TC Report August 12, 2026

Fire Board

- In our 6/11/26 meeting we passed a resolution for \$22 million to build 5 new fire stations in the future. During our 7/9/26 meeting we held a public meeting to get input from the public about the resolution passed in June. There were no public in attendance, and we received no public input in writing prior to the meeting. We then voted to proceed with the issuance of not more than \$22 million of Lease Revenue Bonds.

Community Renewable Energy Agency

- Our communication committee is working on a flyer to send out to RMP customers explaining the opt out notice and the cost of the program. This flyer will have to be approved by RMP before we send it out.
- I want to again clarify that the program we have set up is called the Community Clean Energy Program (because the state legislature wants this to be the name). The organization of the 16 communities in this program is called the Utah Renewable Communities (URC).
- As mandated by the state, schedule 135 residential customers (roof top solar) are not eligible to be part of this program. However, schedule 135 commercial customers are eligible to participate in the program.
- Our program will be labeled schedule 100. RMP will be filing schedule 100 with the PSC (Public Service Commission) early this month so that RMP can start sending opt out notices in November of this year.

Projects that were completed

- Culinary water leak located in SR9 near 839 Zion Park Boulevard was completed on Wednesday July 15th. Culinary water service was never actually interrupted. Crews were able to isolate the shutoff impact to just a single customer service line.

Ongoing Project Updates

- LDS Church to Quail sidewalk project
 - This project is still in the design and approval phases within the Udot agency.
- Sewer Filter Building Project
 - Sunrise Engineering has been tasked with scheduling the remaining items, finalizing those designs and getting the final costs from the contractor.

Budgeted Projects tentatively scheduled to begin in Aug

- No new projects expected to begin in August
