Dear Rocky Mountain Power customer:

Exciting News! Together with Rocky Mountain Power, your community is launching a new renewable energy program. Over the next few years, eligible customers¹, like you, can match up to 100% of their annual electricity use with clean energy through the Community Clean Energy Program.

Utah Renewable Communities is a coalition of cities, counties, and other municipalities (please see footnote below) working together to pioneer renewable energy solutions for our state. Our program, the Community Clean Energy Program, will build new clean energy resources on Rocky Mountain Power's grid to reduce fossil fuel dependence, improve air quality, and limit the greenhouse gas pollution that fuels climate change. You'll remain a Rocky Mountain Power customer with reliable service while supporting cleaner energy.

Billing Impacts for Residential Customers

Participating in this new program is simple. You will be automatically enrolled in the Community Clean Energy Program unless you choose to opt out by January 1, 2027 (please refer to the section entitled **How Do I Opt Out?** below).

Customers that do not opt out of the program by January 1, 2027, will see a small additional charge on their monthly Rocky Mountain Power bill of \$4.00 beginning with service on or after January 1, 2027. This \$4.00 monthly charge will apply regardless of the amount of energy a participating customer uses each month and is in addition to Rocky Mountain Power's service charges. This additional charge collected from all enrolled customers will help pay for the construction of new clean energy resources for the Community Clean Energy Program.

¹ Rocky Mountain Power customers, other than those on Schedule 135 Net Metering Service (closed since 2017), in the following 16 Utah communities are eligible to participate: Alta, Castle Valley, Emigration Canyon, Francis, Grand County, Holladay, Midvale, Millcreek, Moab, Oakley, Ogden, Park City, Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, Springdale and Summit County. Customers who generate and export solar energy to the grid using Schedule 136 Transition Program for Customer Generators (closed since 2020) or Schedule 137 Net Billing Service are eligible to participate.

As shown above, households enrolled in the **Schedule 3 Low-Income Lifeline Program** will receive an enhanced monthly bill credit of \$4.00 every month to help offset the cost of the program.

Customers that do not opt out of the program by January 1, 2027, may later choose to cancel their participation at any time. You can cancel your participation at any time before May 1, 2027, without incurring a termination fee. If you cancel your participation after May 1, 2027, you may be required to pay a termination fee to exit the Community Clean Energy Program as shown below:

As shown above, households enrolled in **Schedule 3 Low-Income Lifeline Program** will not pay any termination fee. The termination fee may be adjusted by order of the Utah Public Service Commission.

You can opt out of the program in one of three easy ways:

More Information

The Community Clean Energy Program rate was approved by the Utah Public Service Commission and finalized through ordinance adoption by the 16 participating communities. The program rate

may be changed once per year upon approval by the Utah Public Service Commission. Rates may change when there are changes in administrative costs or as additional renewable energy resources are acquired, but all changes will be subject to Commission review and approval.
