Dear Board Members,

I am writing to respectfully request School Board approval for an amendment to Bloomington Elementary School's 26-27 TSSA budget.

Our current TSSA budget includes funds designated to hire four SEE students to provide additional support within our school. We have successfully hired two SEE students, and will not be able to fill the remaining two positions. As a result, we are requesting that these funds be reallocated to support professional learning for our teachers through LETRS (Language Essentials for Teachers of Reading and Spelling) training.

This amendment reflects our continued commitment to improving literacy outcomes for all students. LETRS provides educators with evidence-based professional learning grounded in the science of reading, equipping teachers with the knowledge and instructional practices necessary to strengthen reading instruction across classrooms. Investing in this training will have a lasting impact by building teacher capacity and improving instruction for current and future students.

We respectfully request approval of this amendment to allow the designated TSSA funds to be used for LETRS professional education in place of hiring 2 SEE students.
