

2026 KID Water Use

- May use was up 1% from May last year
- Year to date we are down 2% overall from our use in 2025.

Projects

5400 S. Water Line Phase 2

The contractor has finished installing the water line in 5400 South and will be paving the asphalt in the road and at our Hercules Tank Site on 5400 South near Mountain View Corridor tomorrow. The project will be completed within the roadway. The contractor will clean up and complete the project by end of the week. This waterline upsizing and replacement will enhance the water quality, water flow, and pressure regulation for the community east of 5600 West down to Northwest Avenue.

4865 South Water Line Replacement Project

The 4865 South project is close to being completed. The final tie-in will be done tomorrow, Tuesday June 9th, 2026, at the intersection of 4180 W & 4865 South. All 11 residential service lines have now been connected into the newly constructed 12" main in 4865 S. Crews have also connected into the existing mains at 4300 W, 4340 W & 4380 W. Concrete waterways, gutters, and sidewalk restoration will also start this week in anticipation for Preferred Paving to start the asphalt restoration the week of June 22nd.

Staff will work with Salt Lake County Operations to stripe and replace the crosswalk markings that were impacted during construction.

Anticipate all work to be completed by July 1, 2026, as promised to the residents at the beginning of the project.

Sams Boulevard Water Line Project

The contractor will start construction on Tuesday June 16th. Having received permission they will be storing material in the south parking lot of Oquirrh Hills Elementary School. The contractor will start in 4015 West at Sams Boulevard with a new 12-inch water line that will be replacing an existing 6" line, then going along the west side of Sam's Boulevard adjacent to the Kearns Jr. High School up to the 4320 West intersection. New fire hydrants will be installed in the park strip along Sams Boulevard. Work is anticipated to be completed by mid-August. This will provide greater fire protection capabilities for the junior high and surrounding community.

Grant Funding

In 2026, KID staff have secured a total of \$1,131,000 in grant funding for the District.

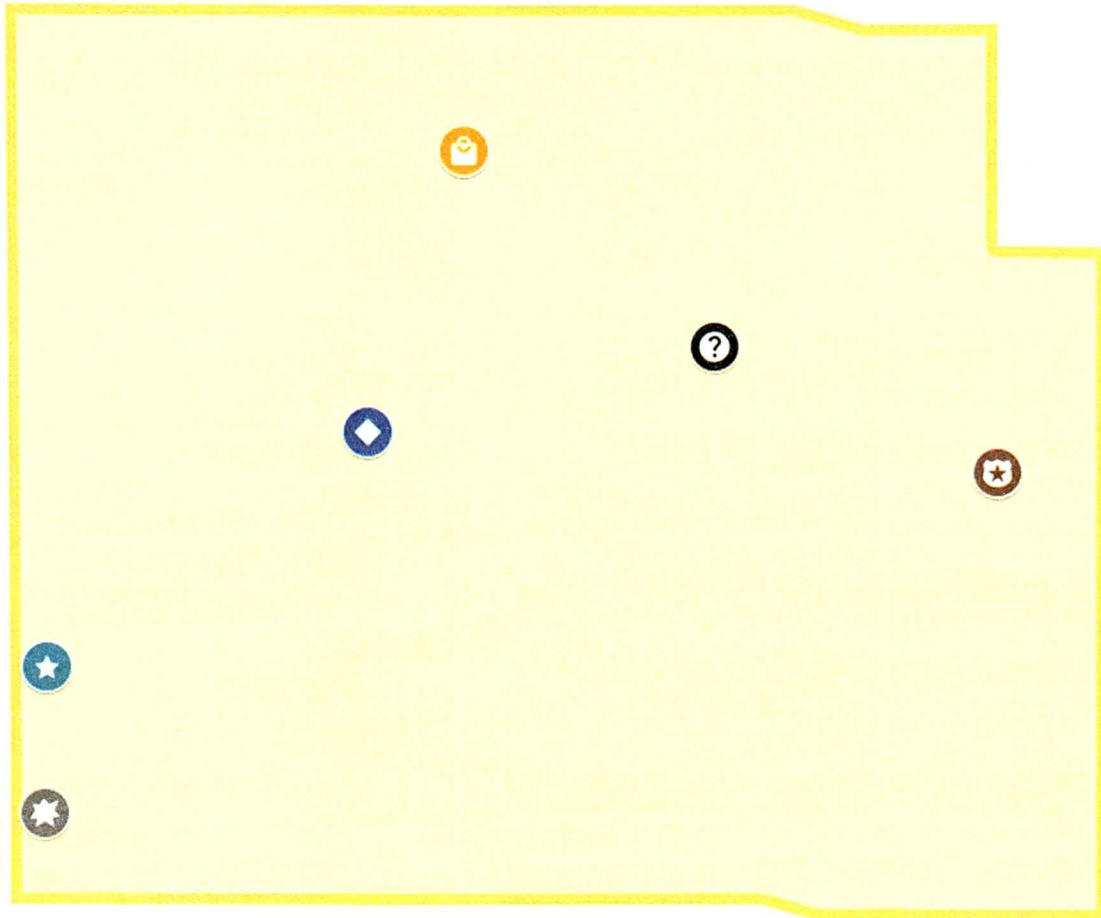

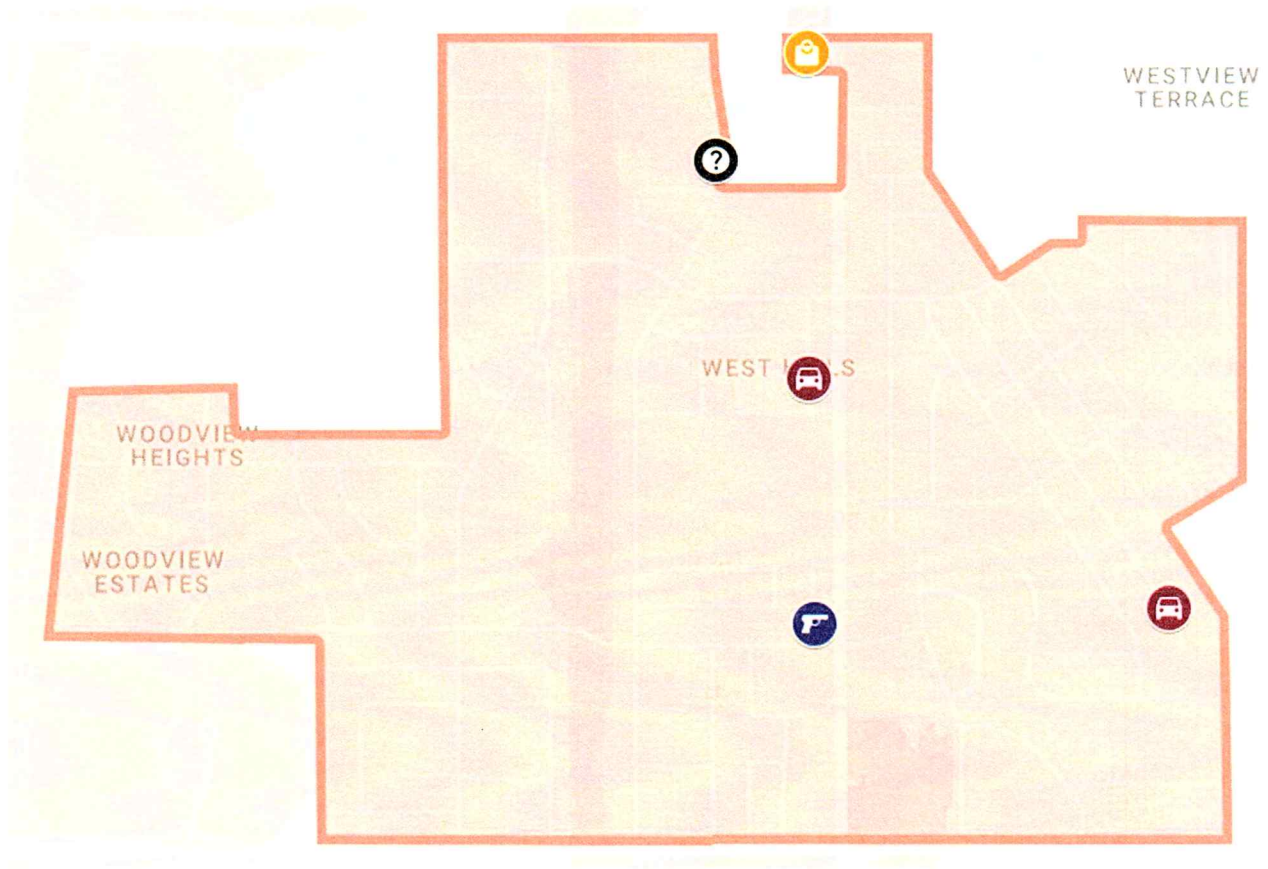
