ORDINANCE NO. 2026-O-08

DATE: July 13, 2026

AN ORDINANCE OF THE KEARNS CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING AN OFFICIAL CITY MAP

WHEREAS, Utah Code §§ 10-20-102(54) and 10-20-408 collectively authorize the City of Kearns (“**Kearns**”) to adopt an official map as an element of the Kearns General Plan; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code §§ 10-20-204 and 10-20-405, the Kearns Planning Commission held public hearings regarding a proposed official map on June 1, 2026, and July 6, 2026; and

WHEREAS, after a public hearing held on July 6, 2026, the Planning Commission voted to favorably recommend that the Kearns City Council (“**Council**”) adopt the proposed map as the City’s official map, subject to the inclusion of the following changes: (a) remove the reference to “Smart Kids Daycare”; (b) remove school names; (c) remove certain addresses; (d) depict playgrounds in the parks; (e) indicate the location of the Kearns Veterans Memorial; (f) make corrections to the color of Oquirrh Park; and (g) update the names of the fire stations within Kearns (collectively, the “**Recommended Changes**”); and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the proposed map, the Council desires to adopt the map as the official map for Kearns and to include the map as an element of the Kearns General Plan, subject to the inclusion of the Recommended Changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Kearns City Council that:

1. Adoption. The map attached to this ordinance is adopted as the official map of the City of Kearns and as an element of the Kearns General Plan, subject to the inclusion of the Recommended Changes.

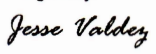
2. Savings Clause. In the event one or more of the provisions of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unenforceable or invalid in any respect under applicable laws, such unenforceability or invalidity shall not affect any other provision; and in such an event, this ordinance shall be construed as if such unenforceable or invalid provision had never been contained herein.

3. Direction to Mayor and Staff. The Mayor and staff are authorized and directed to take such steps as may be needed: (a) for this ordinance to become effective under Utah law, including but not limited to compliance with the requirements of Utah Code § 10-3-711; (b) to incorporate the Recommended Changes into the map; (c) to include the map with the Recommended Changes as an element of the Kearns General Plan; and (d) to finalize and post the ordinance and map to Municode, including but not limited to making non-substantive edits to correct any scrivener’s, formatting, and numbering errors.

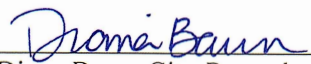
4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect on August 1, 2026.

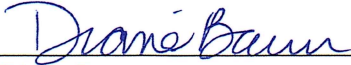
