Charter School's Mission Statement:	Endeavor Hall serves students desiring to acquire superior writing skills in the context of an academically challenging curriculum in preparation for success in collegiate studies, careers, and civic communications.
Charter School's Purpose:	Provide student learning through the use of intensive and targeted writing instruction, alongside the implementation of Core Knowledge. Endeavor Hall allows Educators to actively participate in the designing and implementing of the learning program at the School. Educators will work with published authors to create a supplementary language arts program where students will have the opportunity to publish their writing. Endeavor Hall employs authentic assessment. Authentic assessment is defined as evaluating a student's learning through use of student writing portfolios, performance, or observations in place of or in conjunction with more traditional measures of performance such as tests and written assignments.
Key Elements of the Charter School:	• Focused emphasis on writing with a mission to produce competent and accomplished writers using practices proven to boost writing ability. • Writing is not taught as an isolated subject but is incorporated throughout the day in all academic subjects. • Employs authentic assessment - evaluating student learning through use of student writing portfolios, performance, or observations in place of or in conjunction with more traditional measures of performance such as tests and written assignments. • Displays work samples, visual charts stating goals and tracking progress, and other highly visible reminders and reinforcements of Endeavor Hall's writing emphasis. • Each student will publish two Writers in Residence projects per year to his/her Endeavor Hall writing portfolio. • Uses the Core Knowledge Sequence. • A character education program is taught school wide. • Assessments reflect academic progress generally, and writing skills, as a measurement of successful implementation of Endeavor Hall's mission. • Maintains a large enough student population to offer all programmatic elements listed in the approved charter application.
