

OSTA Advisory Committee Meeting May 12, 2026

Meeting was called to order at 5:30 p,

In attendance : Kathleen Wilson, Mike McCurdy, Bob Kraft and Krista Wilson

Mike McCurdy made the motion to approve the minutes from the February 10, 2026 meeting. Bob Kraft 2nd the motion and the motion carried with no corrections or additions.

Citizens to be Heard: Mike reported that he had been contacted by several citizens about use of the ball fields for practice. Citizens declined to attend meeting because of fear of retaliation. Citizens commented on of ballfields and soccer fields. They ask why they are not allowed to use the fields. Comments have not been sent to county administrator.

Reports were not submitted by the director or assistant director.

Board Member Reports:

Kathy Questioned why meeting had been scheduled since February, and arena staff was unable to attend. .

Would like the arena staff to follow protocol for meetings. Mike McCurdy stated he thought the meeting had been moved to Wednesday to avoid conflict with council meetings.

Question on open board position. An individual had asked arena staff about the opening and was told it was already filled. Bob will reach out to this individual to reapply.

Mike made a motion to table the review of the application received in December to let other people apply, at which time we can call a special meeting or wait until the August meeting to make the appointment.

Bob seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Numerous emails were sent to arena staff asking for a report on water situation, what was being done to conserve and if there was budget to pay for pump charges. Did not receive a response.

Grand Water has access for trucks to fill with water @ \$12.00 per thousand,

Dust control is an issue for events, needs to be implemented for health and safety

Mike asked to get emails on lists of needs

Commission Report:

Commission approved money for extra concrete need for the pickle ball/playground project.

Lights also approved.

Lots of citizens reaching out to council members with concerns

2 events wanted to use OSTA on the same weekend, possible to use different areas, not possible to both use indoor arena. No follow up report

Mike would like to have a open discussion with camp parks at next meeting about establishing camping at OSTA grounds for event attendees. With a fee and dry camping at this time.

Camping could bring in a large revenue source.
