



Beaver City Council Meeting Minutes

July 14, 2026 – 7:00 PM

Mayor Matt Robinson offered the opening prayer, pledge and thought.

Eagle Scout Project- Sklyer Shepard:

Skyler Shepard, a local youth member of the Boy Scouts presented to the city council his proposed Eagle Scout service project involving improvements to the Daughters Of Utah Pioneers Building located on the Main Street Park. Skyler outlined his plan to help improve the historic building including support under the porch and repainting the exterior of the building to enhance the appearance of the building.

Skyler spends a lot of time at the building as a scout. He wants to make the building safe for future scouts to use.

Skyler has a rough quota of \$550.00 for repairs. He plans on assistance from his fellow scouts, young men's group, his parents, and scoutmaster.

Motion to approve \$750.00 for repairs for the DUP building was made by Council Member Randy Hunter, Second by Council Member Lance Cox. The motion passed unanimously.

City Council Minutes Approved:

Minutes of the previous **regular council meeting and emergency council meeting** were presented. Council Member Tyler Schena motioned, and Council Member Randy Hunter seconded to approve the minutes from **June 23, 2026, and June 24, 2026.**

Bills Approval:

Bills were presented and reviewed by City Council Members David Albrecht and Hunter Holt. Council Member Hunter Holt motioned, and Council Member Lance Cox seconded to approve the proposed bills for **June 23 to July 13, 2026**, as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

Beaver City Pool Discussion:

City Council asked that staff provide them with an update on the Beaver City Pool. Executive assistant Taylor Gillins told council that we can no longer staff the facility and are planning on noticing an announcement of the pool's closure.

The notice outlines that season pass holders can receive a prorated reimbursement for unused portion of the swim season.

Sunrise Engineering Glade Nielson shared that water shed protection. Note of interest.

Reports, Updates, Old Business Follow Up: Elected Officials and Staff:

Executive Assistant Taylor Gillins:

She asked what we are going to do about the 24th of July fireworks. Mayor Robinson reported that there is ongoing coordination with himself and George Humpries. They are remaining optimistic about the future firework show due to the rainfall in the forecast. There was also an alternative location briefly discussed.

Taylor also informed council that the pressurized irrigation had been shut off as a precautionary measure to prevent municipal infrastructure from damage from the mud and silt.

Council Member Tyler Schena:

Tyler informed the council that the candy for their portion of the parade has been ordered and he got 6 boxes for each golf cart.

Power Superintendent David Martin:

David reported that hydropower infrastructure had been shut down, pipes secured, and air vents re-gasketed.

Mayor Matt Robinson:

Mayor reported that of the two water lines serving Baker's Canyon, the other ductile iron line has been shut down. The HDPE line is planned to remain operational, with emergency monitoring procedures in place. Residents in the Grove area are advised to maintain a supply of drinking water as a precautionary measure.

Closed Session:

Council Member Tyler Schena motioned, and Council Member Randy Hunter seconded to move into closed session to discuss pending or imminent litigation. Council Members Holt, Cox, Schena, Albrecht, and Hunter voted yea by roll call vote. Motion passed with a unanimous vote. The Council moved into closed session at 7:38 p.m. and moved out at 8:35 p.m.

Present in the above closed session: Mayor Matt Robinson, Council Members Hunter Holt, Lance Cox, Tyler Schena, David Albrecht, Randy Hunter, and Executive Assistant Taylor Gillins, City Recorder Meranda Martin, and Power Superintendent David Martin.
