GREEN WASTE RECOVERY - SALES & DELIVERY CONDITIONS

1. Product availability: Mulch and compost are sold only while supplies last. Compost will be released for sale only after CSWA completes the applicable curing, screening, testing, and quality-control review.
2. Loading and pickup: Posted product prices include standard on-site loading by CSWA equipment during operating hours. Customers must follow staff directions and cover or otherwise secure all outbound loads before leaving the facility. Bagged compost is pickup only.
3. Trailer delivery: A minimum order of 4 CY is required. The maximum volume is 10 CY per trip. Multiple trips are charged separately.
4. Roll-of delivery: Roll-of delivery is available in 18-CY or 40-CY containers, subject to equipment availability and material type. Actual volume might be reduced to comply with vehicle, container, roadway, and legal weight limits. Material is tipped at delivery. Ongoing container rental is not included.
5. Distance calculation: Haul-trailer delivery charges are based on the one-way mileage from the Moab Landfill entrance to the delivery destination, rounded to the nearest whole mile. Roll-of delivery charges are based on the applicable round-trip service time.
6. Scheduling: At least one business days' notice is required. Delivery dates and times depend on staffing, equipment, product inventory, weather, road conditions, and operational priorities. Deliveries are NOT available on weekends or holidays.
7. Delivery site access: The customer must provide a safe, firm, level, and accessible unloading location with adequate turning radius and overhead clearance. CSWA may refuse or reschedule a delivery when access or unloading conditions are unsafe. The customer is responsible for identifying the requested placement location.
8. Product variability: Recovered organic products naturally vary in color, texture, moisture, and particle size. Customers should confirm that the selected material is suitable for the intended application before purchase.
9. Billing: Invoice ticket totals are rounded to the nearest whole dollar. Finance charges of 1.5% per month may be assessed on approved charge accounts more than 30 days past due.

- ***Waste tire loads with rims will be charged 1.5 times the applicable fee.
- Surcharge of 2 dollars per mile for deliveries requiring travel via unpaved roads.
- Haul rates include disposal or reclamation rates, where applicable.
- Additional container sizes may be available. Contact for details and pricing.
- Container relocation rates are the same as delivery rates.
- Concrete or Asphalt containers can only be filled to 75 percent of the container capacity to adhere to transportation weight restrictions.
- Scrap metal must be free from other debris or trash. Depending upon the amount, scrap metal with contamination will be charged a sorting fee or disposal fee, which may include a 2 hour round trip to the Klondike Landfill.
- Waste tire loads containing debris or trash will be charged the applicable sorting fee plus additional disposal charges, where applicable.
- Cardboard hauls containing large amounts of debris or trash will be charged the MSW and C and D haul rate.
- Tires, appliances, and scrap metal loaded into cleanup containers mixed with MSW and C and D material are acceptable but will incur container sorting fees specified above.
- All Special Wastes, including non friable asbestos and contaminated soils, require approval from CSWA management via the issuance of a Special Waste Profile and Manifest prior to container delivery.
- Containers that do not get hauled at least once per month will incur two times the above-listed Daily Rental fees for each container per day beginning on the second month after the container delivery date.

- The maximum allowable weight for any 20 CY or 30 CY container is ten (10) tons.
- Containers can only be hauled when loaded level with the top of the container. Overloaded containers will not be hauled.
- Overloaded containers will be charged container sorting fees specified above. Unless prearranged, we do not accept dirt, rock, sod, stumps, root balls, or asphalt shingles.
- No hazardous materials or hazardous waste accepted, including liquids, chemicals, and paints of any kind.
