

ADOPTION OF THE 2026 FEE STRUCTURE FOR FACILITIES SERVICES

WHEREAS the Administrative Control Board (the "Board") of the Solid Waste Special Service District#1 (District) is authorized to establish fees for services and the hours of operation at the District's facilities; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing to hear comments on the proposed fee structure was posted in 5 public locations within in Moab, Grand County, State of Utah on the 12 of August 2026, noticed on the Utah Public Notice Website at <https://www.utah.gov/pmn/index.html>, and said fee structure was available for public inspection in advance of the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, such hearing was held at 6:00 p.m. on August 19, 2026; and

WHEREAS, a written public comment period was allowed through 6:00 p.m., Wednesday, August 19, 2026; and

WHEREAS, verbal public comments were permitted during the public comments portion of the public hearing online via Zoom Video Communications, and all public comments received during the public hearing through the end of the public comment period were taken into consideration;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and enacted by the Solid Waste Special Service District#1's Administrative Control Board, that the following be formally adopted as the 2026 Fee Structure for Commercial Oil Collection Services to be effective October 1, 2026:

GREEN WASTE RECOVERY - SALES & DELIVERY CONDITIONS

- Product availability:** Mulch and compost are sold only while supplies last. Compost will be released for sale only after CSWA completes the applicable curing, screening, testing, and quality-control review.
- Loading and pickup:** Posted product prices include standard on-site loading by CSWA equipment during operating hours. Customers must follow staff directions and cover or otherwise secure all outbound loads before leaving the facility. Bagged compost is pickup only.
- Trailer delivery:** A minimum order of 4 CY is required. The maximum volume is 10 CY per trip. Multiple trips are charged separately. Product and delivery fees are calculated independently.
- Roll-off delivery:** Roll-off delivery is available in 20-CY or 30-CY containers as equipment and material allow. Actual volume may be reduced to comply with vehicle, container, roadway, and legal weight limits. Material is tipped at delivery; ongoing container rental is not included.
- Distance calculation:** Distance is the one-way mileage from the Moab Landfill entrance to the delivery destination, rounded to the nearest whole mile. A destination measured at 5.5 miles is billed in the >5-10 mile tier.
- Scheduling:** At least one business day's notice is required. Delivery dates and times depend on staffing, equipment, product inventory, weather, road conditions, and operational priorities. Deliveries are NOT available on the weekends or federally recognized holidays.
- Delivery site access:** The customer must provide a safe, firm, level, and accessible unloading location with adequate turning radius and overhead clearance. CSWA may refuse or reschedule a delivery when access or unloading conditions are unsafe. The customer is responsible for identifying the requested placement location.
- Inbound contamination:** Green waste containing trash, construction debris, soil, rock, concrete, asphalt, bags, twine, or other contaminants may be rejected or charged at the current applicable Moab Landfill disposal rate.
- Product variability:** Recovered organic products naturally vary in color, texture, moisture, and particle size. Customers should confirm that the selected material is suitable for the intended application before purchase.
- Billing:** Invoice ticket totals are rounded to the nearest whole dollar. Finance charges of 1.5% per month may be assessed on approved charge accounts more than 30 days past due.
