1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER: Wade called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

2. BUSINESS ITEMS – Wade Woolstenhulme:

- REVIEW MINUTES FROM LAST MEETING: Wade reviewed action items from March meeting. The following action items were discussed:

- a. Add Pink Night to next meeting's agenda.
- b. Coordinate with Public Works regarding assistance with installation of bucking chutes.
- c. Wade to confirm payout reimbursement for John (barrel man) related to covering the Coors logo.

DECISION POINT: *Matt Russell motioned to approve minutes March 2, 2026 and Jake Woolstenhulme seconded the motion. Voting results: consensus approval.*

- National Anthem Singers:
 - Ten applications were received prior to the meeting.
 - Josh Kelley was suggested; however, he has not applied for this year.
 - The committee discussed allowing youth participants to perform the National Anthem.
 - A barbershop quartet performing on July 4th was also discussed.
- Exclusivity Updates:
 - Xtreme Bulls: Opportunity available to sponsor a third bullfighter. Iron Horse Equipment was suggested by Cody Thornton.

- Chute Sponsorship: Currently held by Ballerina Farm, which is no longer sponsoring the Junior Rodeo.

 - Available Sponsorships:
- **Partner Updates & Adjustments:**
 - Bill White:
 - Unable to provide cash sponsorship this year due to financial impacts.
 - Will continue in-kind contributions, including food services.
 - Committee supports maintaining banner placement due to longstanding partnership.
 - Silver Star Sponsorship:
 - Adjusted to approximately \$1,000 sponsorship level.
 - Includes event ticket purchases.
 - Banner placement revised accordingly.
 - Park City Chamber / County Sponsors:
 - Park City Chamber reducing ticket allocation.
 - County Health Department maintaining current sponsorship level.
- **Lodging & Room Sponsorships:**
 - Black Rock
 - Approximately 15 one-bedroom suite nights committed.
 - Includes potential availability of penthouse suite (not currently assigned).
 - Sheraton
 - Continuing standard allocation of approximately 32 room nights.
- **Infrastructure – Electrical/Power Upgrade Discussion:** A detailed discussion was held regarding electrical capacity and future expansion needs:
 - Cody met with Kent Woolstenhulme and he recommended not converting entire facility to 3-phase power. Instead, install a separate dedicated 3-phase power service with independent transformer and meter.

A. Wade to coordinate with Hoyt and Tommy Joe to confirm voltage specifications, amperage, and wattage requirements.

- **100-Year Commemorative History Book:** Don Weller proposed to create a commemorative history book for the 100th Oakley Rodeo Celebration, including historical photos and stories.

DECISION POINT: Andy Woolstenhulme motioned to approve Don Weller starting on the 100th year commemorative history book for the 100th Oakley Rodeo Celebration and Rustin Young seconded the motion. Voting results: consensus approval.

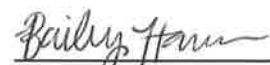
- **Rodeo Committee Picture for Program:** Scheduled for May 4, 2026 in front of the chutes in blue shirts.
