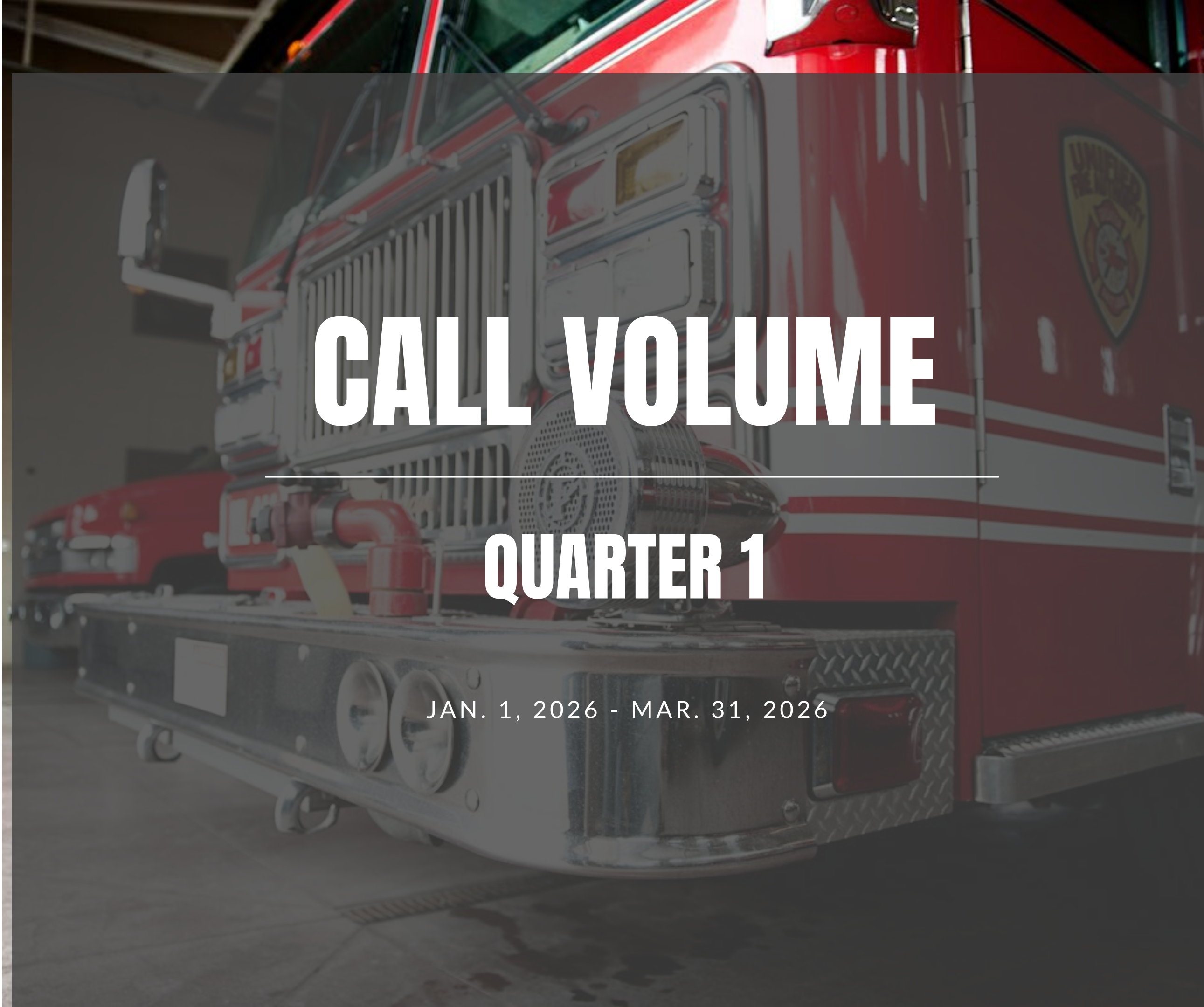

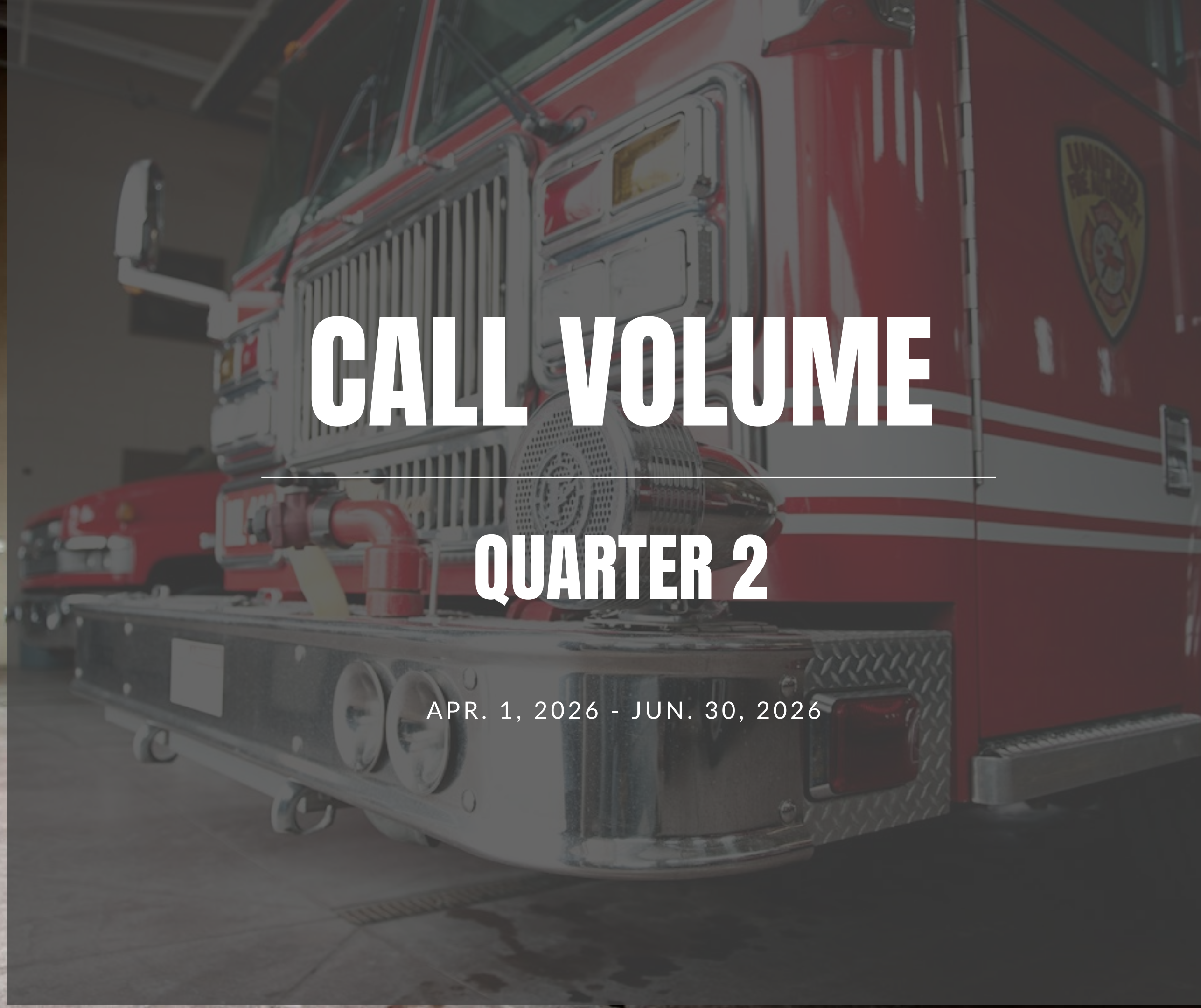

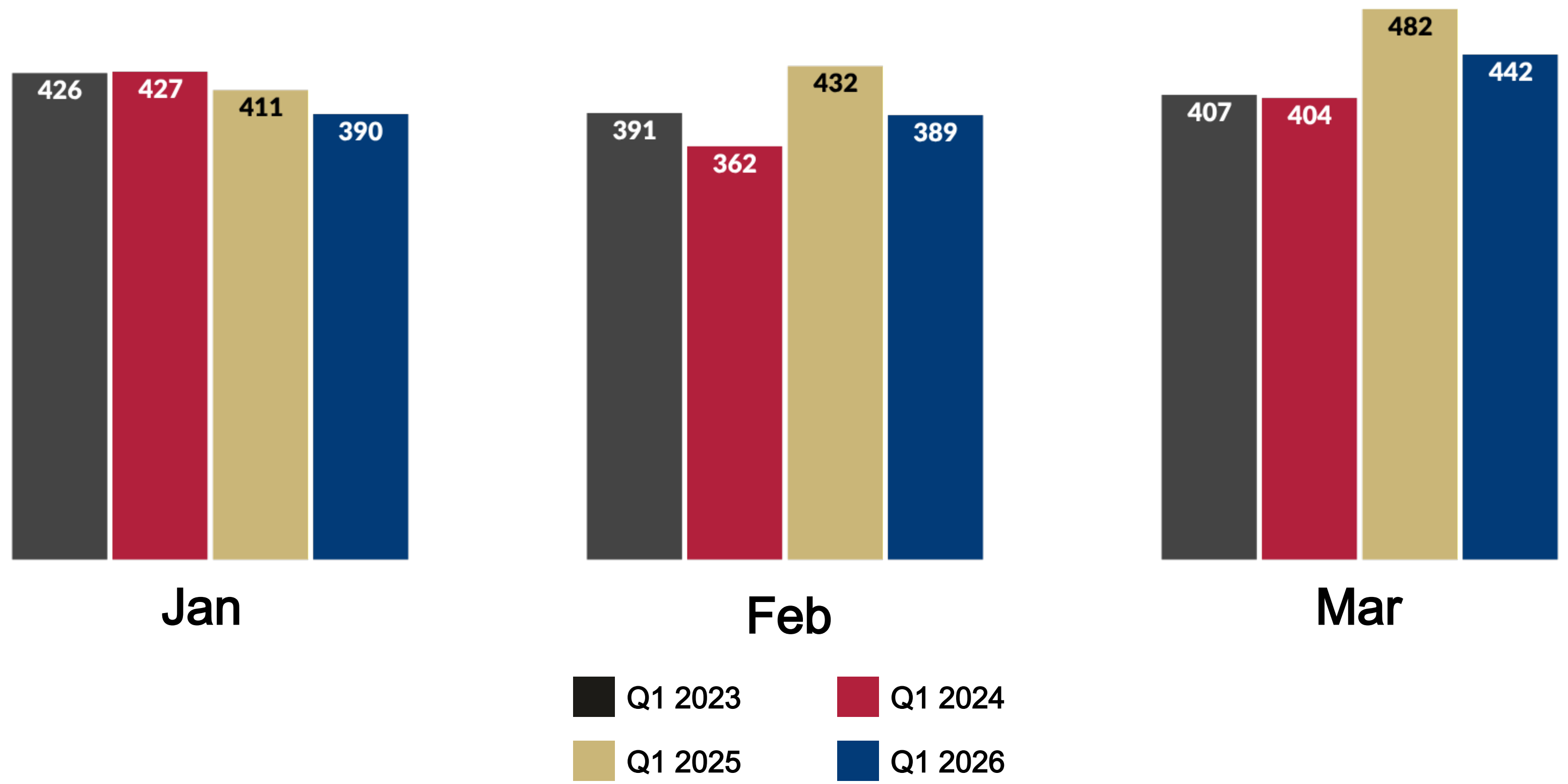

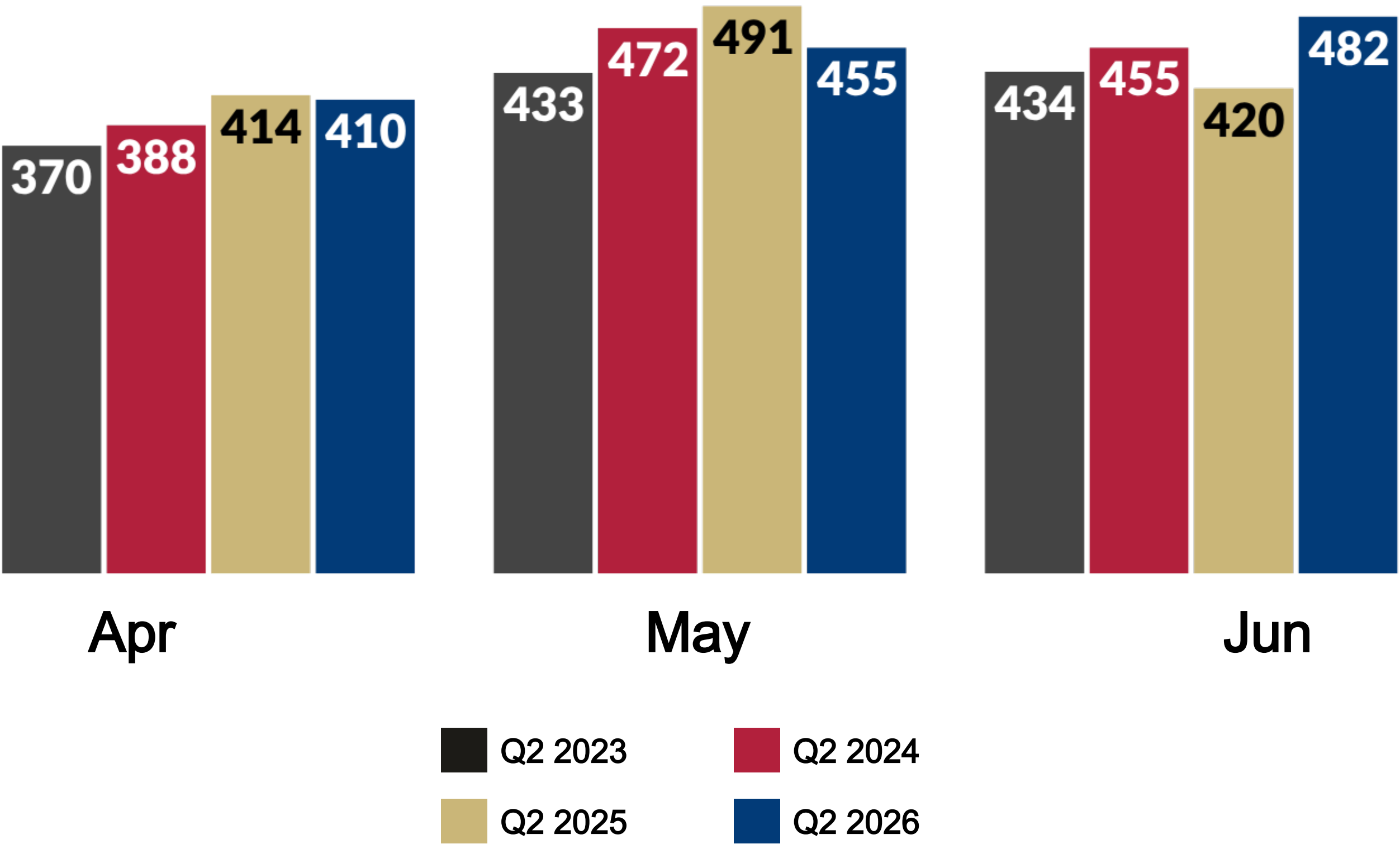


Q1 FOUR YEAR MONTHLY COMPARISON





Q2 FOUR YEAR MONTHLY COMPARISON



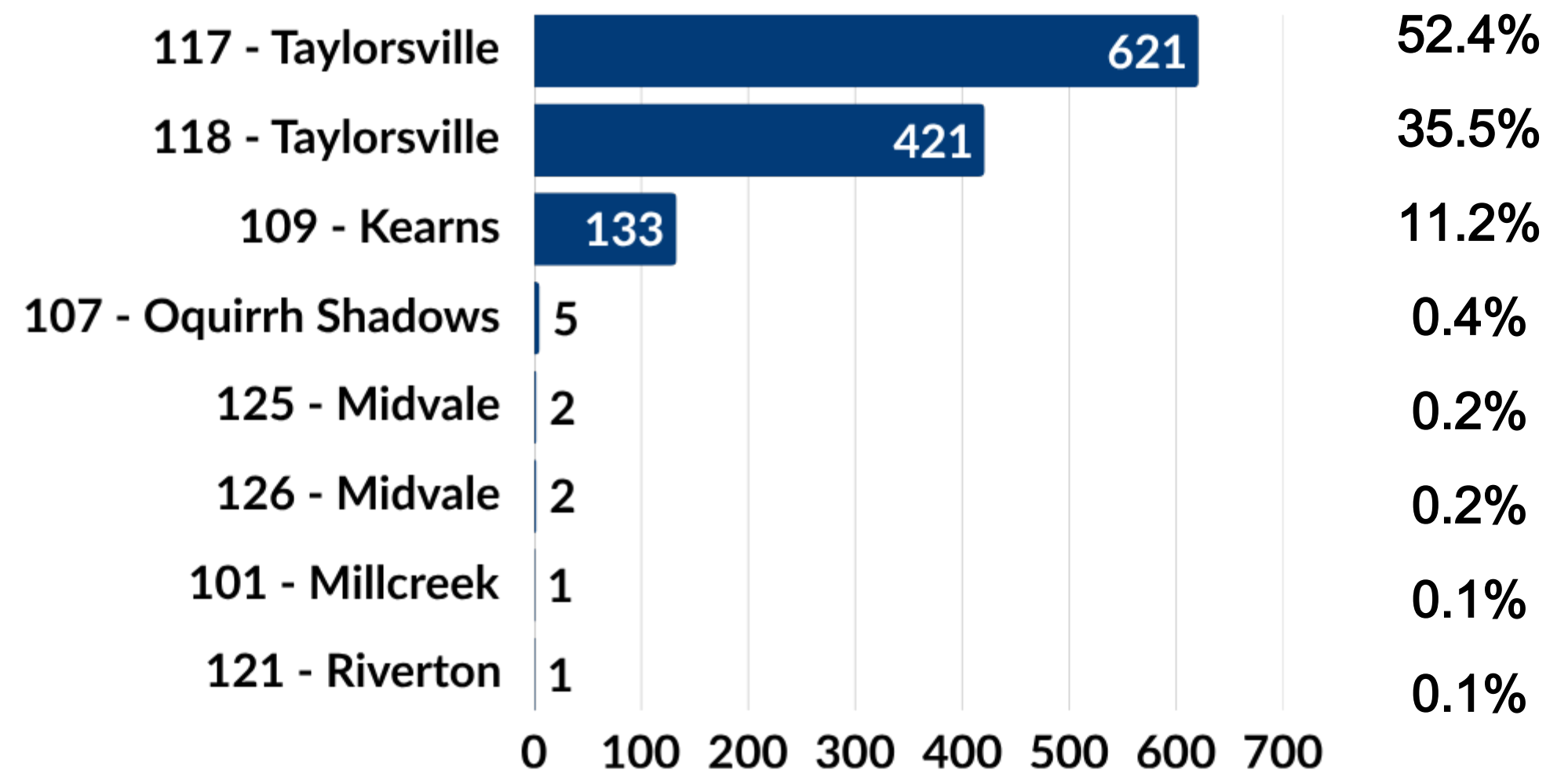

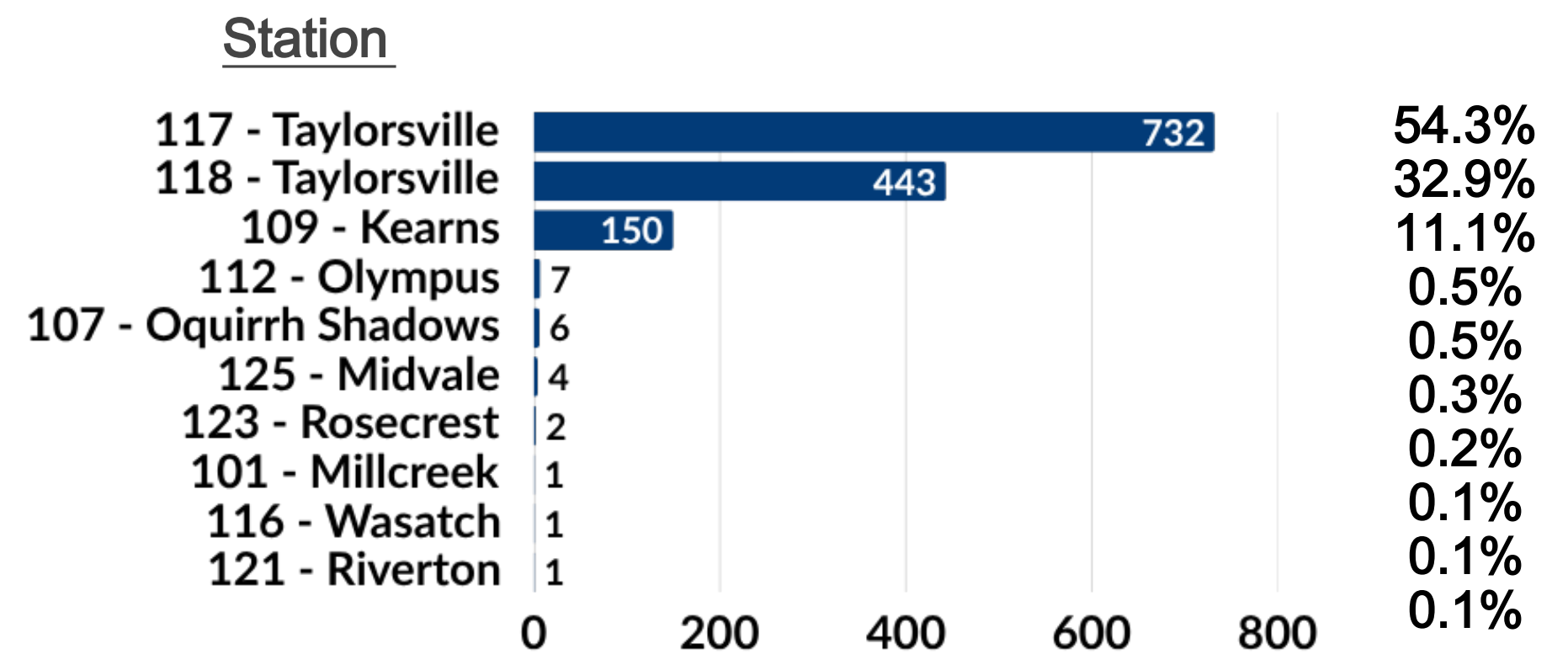

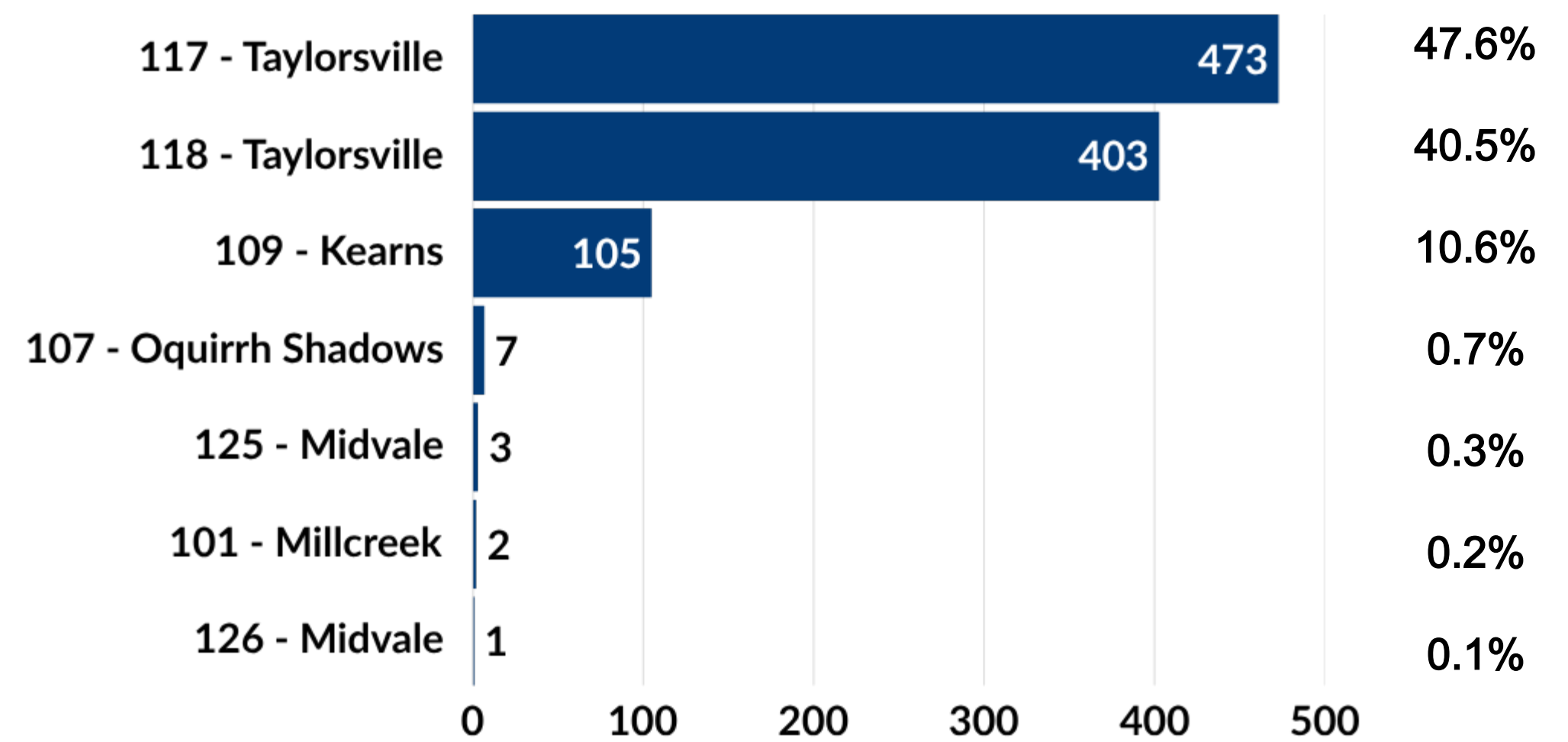

Top Ambulance Responses



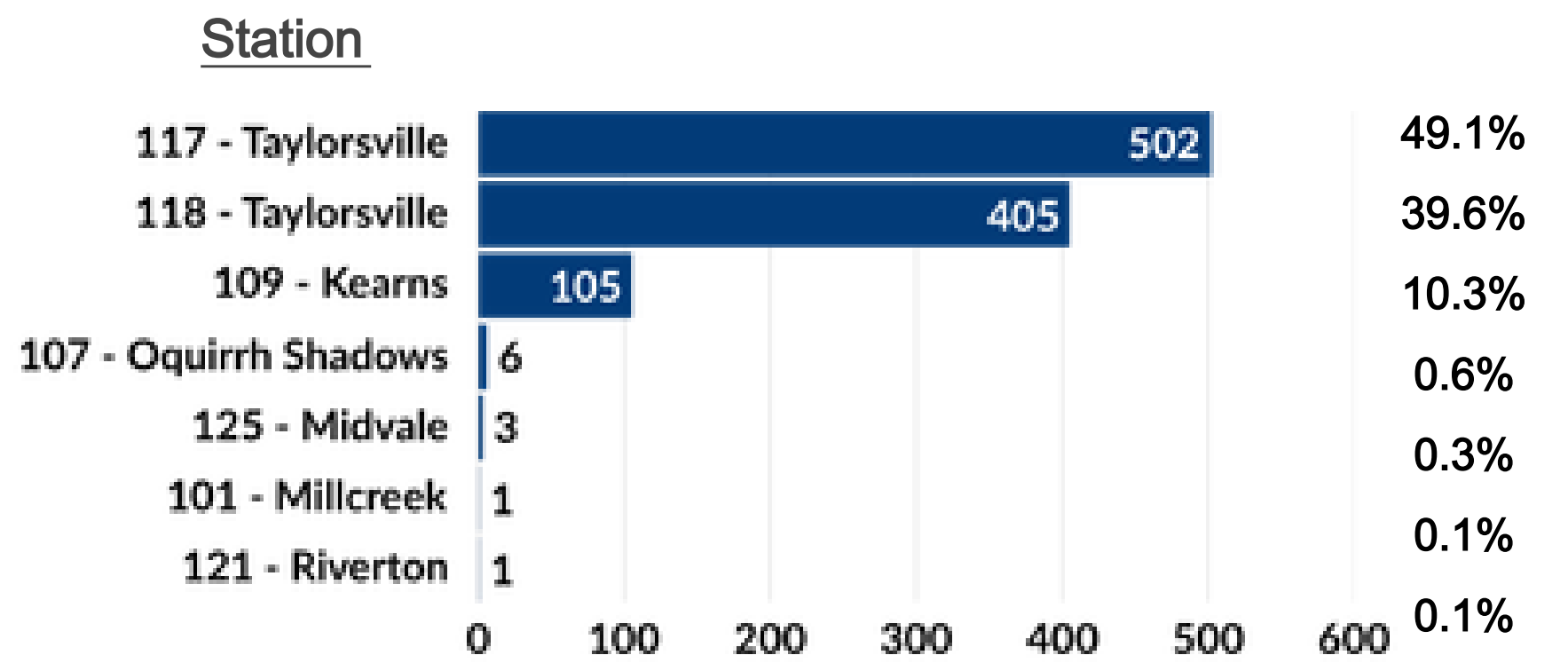

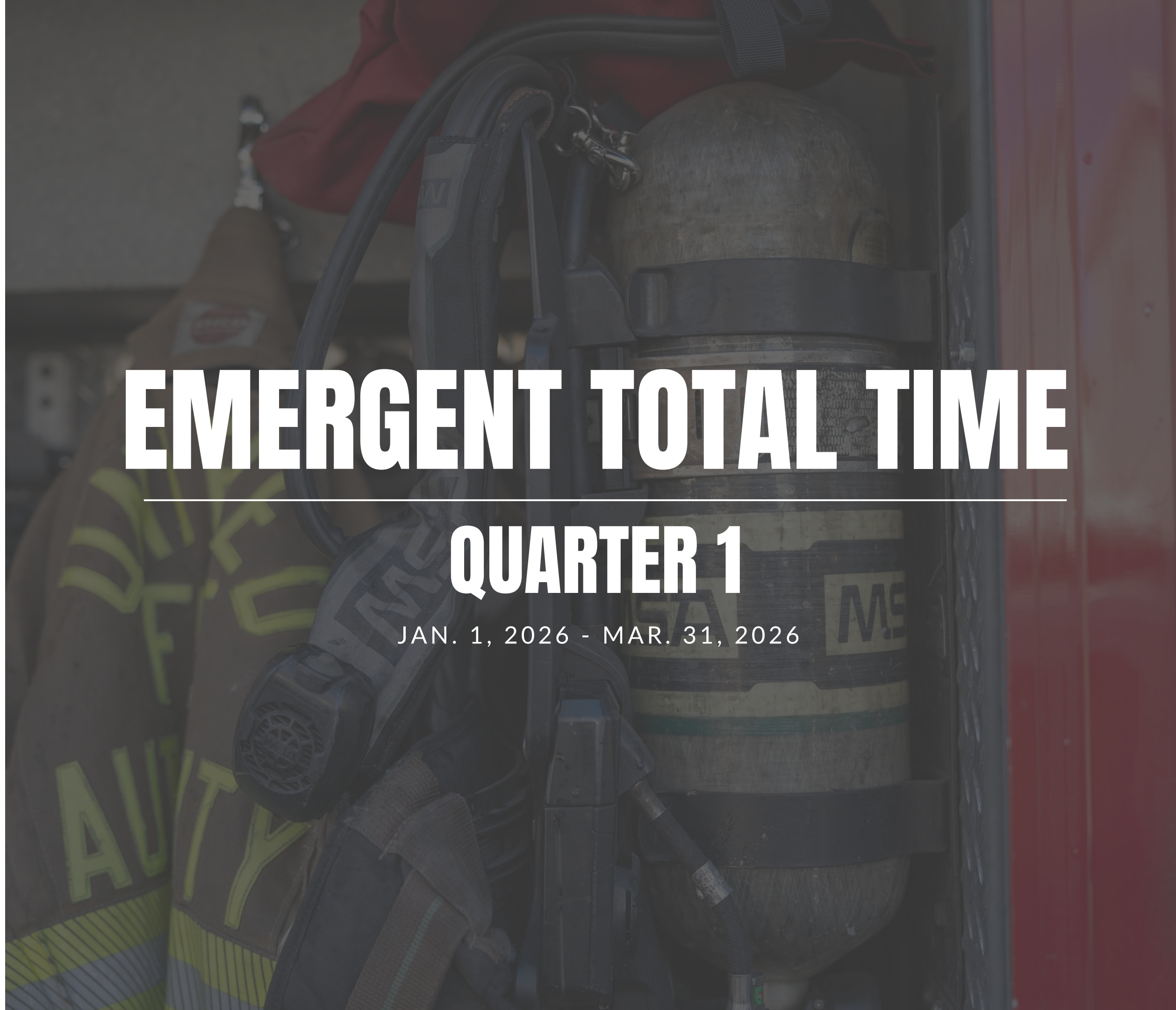

Safety Message

Barbecue Safety

- 10,600 Fires each year (NFPA)
- 19,700 ER Visits
- Never leave the grill unattended while cooking
- Proper clearance from combustibles
- Never use indoors
- Keep fire extinguisher close / know how to shut fuel source
- Never add lighter fluid to a burning fire
- If using coals - properly dispose
